Hickey's Creek Kayak

9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

Thursday, October 6th.

The kayak trip begins and ends at the Caloosahatchee Regional Park campground.

We go along the great Calusa Blueway, one of the area's most scenic waterways. We paddle an hour and a half to Hickey Creek Mitigation Park, eat lunch and stretch our legs on a short hike before we paddle back to Caloosahatchee Regional Park. This trip is best for paddlers with some kayaking

experience and/or in good physical condition for a five-mile roundtrip paddle. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult. All kayaking equipment is provided. Bring your own water, lunch, sunscreen,

binoculars, clothing and shoes that can get wet. We will meet at the campground entrance of Caloosahatchee Regional Park at 19130 North River Road.
