Free Guided Walk on the fourth Saturday at Six Mile Cypress Slough Preserve

Fort Myers, FL, May. 26, 2016 — Join a Volunteer Naturalist for a free guided walk at Six Mile Cypress Slough Preserve on the fourth Saturday of the month between May and October. The first of these Saturday walks is scheduled for May 28 at 9:30 a.m. Arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the tour to pay the parking fee (\$1/hour/vehicle) and check-in with the Volunteer Naturalist at the boardwalk entrance.

The guided walk covers three-quarters of a mile on a fully-accessible, raised boardwalk and lasts 90 minutes. Get to know some of Florida's native plants, learn how to spot diverse wildlife, and find out why the Slough is so important to our community. Participation in the guided walk is first-come, first-served for a maximum of 20 people (10 people per guide). Organized groups of 6 or more people should call 239-533-7555 at least two weeks in advance to arrange a private group tour.
