Criteria: Open to any senior division youth who exhibited at the 2025 SWFL Ag Expo.  
2025 Recipient: Whitney Taylor
- **SWFL 4-H/FFA Exemplary Citizenship Scholarship (\$700)**  
Criteria: Open to any senior division youth who exhibited at the 2025 SWFL Ag Expo.  
2025 Recipient: Veronica Rosauer
- **SWFL 4-H/FFA Graduating Senior Scholarship (\$1,200)**  
Criteria: Open only to graduating FFA and 4-H senior youth who participated in the 2025 SWFL Ag Expo.  
2025 Recipient: Boone Stewart
