 Award Contract for Cartridge Filters for Water Treatment Plants

I. MOTION REQUESTED

A) Award Invitation to Bid No. B190558BAG, Cartridge Filters for Water Treatment Plants – Annual to Tri-Dim Filter Corporation for the purchase of cartridge filters for water treatment plants, on an as needed basis, for an initial term of one year, in the amount of \$104,000.00.

B) Authorize the Chair to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.

C) Grant the County Manager or designee the authority to renew the contract, for up to three additional one-year periods, and to execute all associated documents, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets, if doing so is in the best interest of Lee County, and there are no cost increases associated with the renewal.

II. ITEM SUMMARY

Award contract to Tri-Dim Filter Corporation for the purchase of cartridge filters for an annual amount of \$104,000. This product is used to remove particulate from the feed water at the reverse osmosis and nano filtration facilities. The unit price per filter is less than the previous per unit cost and the contract does not allow for price increases, creating in a potential savings of approximately \$37,700 annually. FY19 expenditures were \$81,400 and the increased annual estimated expenditures are due to projected increased flow demand. Funds are available for this purchase in the Utilities Operating Budget.

III. BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A) Board Action and Other History

Lee County Utilities submitted a request to Procurement Management to obtain bids to supply cartridge filters for the water treatment plants. On October 25, 2019, Procurement Management advertised B190558BAG, Cartridge Filters for Water Treatment Plants – Annual.

On the bidding deadline of December 3, 2019, Procurement Management received one bid. Lee County Utilities and Procurement Management completed an analysis and recommended the contract be awarded to Tri-Dim Corporation, the responsible bidder with the lowest responsive bid, in the amount of \$104,000.00. This product is used to remove particulates from the feed water at the reverse osmosis and nano filtration water treatment plants.

The awarding of this contract will save Lee County Utilities an estimated \$37,750.00 on the purchase of 9000 Melt Blown Cartridge Filters and 4400 Micron Wound Cartridge Filters for the North Lee County, Pine Woods, and Green Meadows Water Treatment Plants due to the reduced cost per filter. The Melt Blown Filters will decrease from \$11.57 each to \$8.50 and the Micron Wound Filters will decrease from \$8.55 each to \$6.25.
