- A. Authorize departments to negotiate individual projects under Bid No. B-140176, Annual Contract for Directional Bore Services, with the contracted vendor, Roberts Drilling, Inc., under Contract No. 6792, on an as needed basis as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets.
- B. Authorize the Director of Procurement Management or designee to approve individual projects up to \$50,000 on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.
- C. Authorize the County Manager or designee to approve individual projects over \$50,000 and up to \$100,000 on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.

II. ITEM SUMMARY

Authorizes departments to negotiate individual projects under Bid No. B-140176, Annual Contract for Directional Bore Services, with the contracted vendor: Roberts Drilling, Inc., Contract No. 6792, on an as needed basis as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets. Total expenditures for these services in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 were: \$71,655. The estimated expenditure in FY 2017-18 is \$250,000.

On May 6, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners awarded Invitation to Bid No. B-140176, Annual Contract for Directional Bore Services, to Roberts Drilling, Inc. for directional bore services for various Lee County projects.

Total expenditures for these services in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 were: \$71,655

Board approval is requested to allow expenditures on an individual project basis and to authorize project approval authority based upon on the level of total project spending.

This contract provides the County with a vendor that can install conduits/pull boxes for fiber optics, traffic signals, street lights, Intelligent Transportation Systems and irrigation for landscaping along roadways to avoid open cuts to the road and lane closures.
