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**TITLE:**

Award Formal Bid for Liquid Lime Residuals Hauling and Disposal

**ACTION REQUESTED:**

A) Award Formal Bid No. ITB-160391/AB, Liquid Lime Residuals Hauling and Disposal, to Youngquist Brothers, Inc., for use on an as-needed basis as approved in the departments' adopted budgets.

B) Authorize the Chair to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.

C) Grant the Director of Procurement Management the authority to renegotiate and execute renewals of these contracts for up to three additional one-year periods, with County Administration approval, under the same terms and conditions, if doing so is in the best interest of Lee County.

**FUNDING:**

LCU Enterprise Fund; Included in the FY16/17 Operating Budget.

Contract may be renewed for up to three additional one-year periods. Funds will be programmed each year from the Utilities Operating Budget.

Lee County Utilities; Green Meadows Water Treatment Plant Operating Funds; Trash, Garbage & Sludge Removal

**WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES:**

Awards Formal Bid No. ITB-160391/AB for the as-needed hauling and disposal of liquid lime residuals to Youngquist Brothers, Inc. for a period of one year for the Green Meadows Water Treatment Plant. Lime residuals are the byproduct of the water treatment process and are generated on a continuous basis. Proper removal and disposal is required per Florida Department of Environmental Protection Guidelines. Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 were \$155,037.60.

On the bidding deadline of June 24, 2016, Procurement Management received three bids. The bids were reviewed by the Utilities Department and it is recommended that award be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder meeting all bid requirements, Youngquist Brothers, Inc.

Youngquist Brothers, Inc. disposal price per gallon of \$0.0549 has remained the same as the previous contract.
