TITLE: Approve Piggyback for Purchase of Portable Generators & Related Equipment - Countywide

I. MOTION REQUESTED

A) Approve Piggyback No. PB200153AEJ to utilize pricing on the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract No. 120617-CMM for Electrical Energy Power Generation with Related Parts, Supplies and Services from Cummins Inc., for the purchase of stationary and portable electrical generators; backup or standby generator sets; mobile or trailer mounted generators and related parts, supplies and services, on an as needed basis, through the contract expiration date of January 29, 2022, and any renewals or extensions approved by the NJPA, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets. Individual purchases in excess of \$100,000.00 will be brought to the Board for approval.

II. ITEM SUMMARY

Approves the use of pricing under the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) contract for Electrical Energy Power Generation with Related Parts, Supplies and Services with Cummins Inc., through the contract expiration date of January 29, 2022, and any renewals or extensions approved by the NJPA. Expenditures during Fiscal Year 2018-2019 were \$466,126.00. Individual purchases in excess of \$100,000.00 will be brought to the Board for approval, and will include a market analysis.

Lee County purchases and maintains emergency generators and is standardized on the Cummins, Inc. brand. Approval of the piggyback contract will allow for the purchase of Cummins generators, related parts, supplies and services to meet the operational needs of the County and take advantage of the pricing and warranty advantages available in the contract.

III. BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A) Board Action and Other History

On May 28, 2013, the Board approved Waiver No. W-130118 to waive the formal quotation procedure to allow purchase of only Cummins brand emergency generator sets from Cummins Power South LLC, when requests to acquire an emergency power system (generator set) is deemed necessary by County Departments and Divisions. Waiver No. W-130118 will be replaced with Piggyback No. PB200153AEJ for future purchases.

On October 19, 2018, the NJPA issued a Request for Proposal that went through the competitive procurement process and negotiations for the purchase of stationary and portable electrical generators; backup or standby generator sets; mobile or trailer mounted generators and related parts, supplies and services. NJPA evaluated a proposal from Cummins, Inc. and awarded contract for the term of January 29, 2018 through January 29, 2022. Procurement Management reviewed the contract and determined it is eligible for piggyback. Approval of the piggyback will allow for the purchase of necessary resources to meet the operational needs of the County.
