1. DESCRIPTION

The Traffic Management Section of the Department of Environment and Infrastructure (DEI) seeks to establish an ongoing contract for the purchase of batteries to be purchased as needed. The batteries will replace older non-functioning ones in Myer Uninterruptible Power Source (UPS) of traffic controller cabinets and solar flasher units.

This contract is for batteries only and includes delivery.

2. AWARD

Award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

3. VENDOR REQUIREMENTS

- A. Provide specification sheet of product being offered.
- B. Other products meeting the below material specifications will be considered. Provide details such as life expectancy, utilization within the State of Florida and the ability to withstand the harsh temperatures for a minimum of three years without failure.
- C. Identify the exact product offered on the Quote Summary page and include the specification.
- D. Provide specific warranty documentation with submittal.

4. MATERIALS

- A. Replacement batteries must fit into Myers UPS units contained within UPS traffic controller cabinets and solar flasher units.
- B. Battery shall meet the following requirements:
 - Power Sonic Model PG-12V103 FR <u>OR</u> AlphaCell™ Premium Gel Cell Model 195 GXL (product sheets attached);
 - 94 Ah, 12 Volt
 - Single or twin handle/strap
 - Top mount bolt on connection (bolt size: one quarter twenty)

5. WARRANTY

A minimum of three (3) years fully warranted with an unconditional and free replacement. Warranty shall take effect when put into service.

6. UNSPECIFIED MATERIALS

This paragraph provides a funding source to address minor unexpected purchases not listed. These purchases require negotiation with the Vendor and require prior authorization from the County Representative. There is no guarantee that the funds identified at the Quote Summary page will be required.

9. REQUESTING & INVOICING

- Invoices shall reference the individual Standard Purchase Order number issued against the Blanket Purchase Order that will be established for this contract.
- Invoices shall identify the individual bid items with extended quantities and pricing.
- Unspecified Monies shall be identified as a separate line item on the invoice. Use of these monies requires prior authorization.

10. Quantities

Quantities stated are an estimate only and no guarantee is given or implied as to quantities that will be used during the contract period. Estimated quantities are based upon previous use and/or anticipated needs.

11. PRICING/PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

Unit prices quote of listed items shall be held firm for the duration of the contract. Duration of the contract shall be for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of contract award and any extension thereof.

12. TERM EXTENSION(S) OF CONTRACT

The contract may be extended subject to written notice of agreement from the County and the successful Quoter(s) for an additional twenty four (24) month period beyond the primary contract period. Term extension will allow for price adjustment (decrease/Increase) in an amount not to exceed the average of the Producer Price Index (PPI) for all Metals and Metal Products, Refined Lead, Series Id: WPU10240449, Not Seasonally Adjusted, Base Date: 199706 for the twelve months prior to extension, or five percent (5%), whichever is less. The extension shall be exercised only if all terms and conditions remain the same and the County Administrator or Director of Purchasing grants approval.

It is the vendor's responsibility to request any pricing adjustment under this provision. For any adjustment to commence on the first day of any exercised extension period, the vendor's request for adjustment should be submitted at time of the extension request from the County. The vendor adjustment request should not be in excess of the relevant pricing index change. If no adjustment request is received from the vendor, the County will assume the vendor has agreed that the extension term may be exercised without pricing adjustment. Any adjustment request received after the commencement of a new extension period may not be considered.

- 1. Pinellas County reserves the right to reject any or all quotations it deems to be in the best interest of the County.
- 2. An award may not be issued without proof that your firm is registered with the Florida Division of Corporations, as per Florida Statute §607.1501 (http://www.flsenate.gov/Laws/Statutes/2011/607.1501).
 - A foreign corporation (foreign to the State of Florida) may not transact business in this state until it obtains a certificate of authority from the Department of State. Please visit www.sunbiz.org for this information on how to become registered.
- 3. In case of default of the awarded quotation, Pinellas County may procure the articles or services from other sources and charge the vendor as liquidated damages any excess cost or damages occasioned thereby.
- 4. All costs accruing from a quotation, challenged as to quality, etc., (tests, etc.) will be assumed by the challenger.
- 5. Vendor shall insert unit price and extension, as required, opposite each item. Unit prices shall be shown and where there is an error in extension or price, the unit price shall govern.
- 6. When a choice of brand name or catalog number is given, circle item being quoted. If quoting on a substitute item, state brand name, catalog number, and indicate any changes in specifications. Manufacturer's information sheets (specifications) brochures, etc., should be attached. Where equal (substitute) is quoted, items must be equal to or exceed material requested. - 7. All material herein shall be fully guaranteed by the vendor against factory defects. Any defects which may occur as the result of either faulty material or workmanship within the period of the manufacturer's standard warranty (said warranty must accompany proposal) will be corrected by the vendor at no expense to Pinellas County.
- 8. Any and all attachments hereto including but not limited to technical specifications, special terms and conditions, etc., are an integral part of the Invitation to Quote.
- Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) Requirements: If any chemicals, materials, or products containing toxic substances, in accordance with OSHA Hazardous Communications Standards, are contained in the products purchased by the County as a result of this bid, the successful bidder shall provide a Material Safety Data Sheet at the time of each delivery.
- 10. Any service to be performed on County premises requires a current Certificate of Insurance (blanket, if possible) in order to proceed with a purchase order. The certificate must show combined single limits of \$500,000 coverages for General Liability, statutory limits for Workers' Compensation, Professional Liability coverage, at minimum \$500,000, for all professional services contracts. Charging

Cycle Applications: Limit initial current to 25.0A. Charge until battery voltage (under charge) reaches 14.4 to 14.7 volts at 68°F (20°C). Hold at 14.4 to 14.7 volts until current drops to under 1.03A. Battery is fully charged under these conditions, and charger should be disconnected or switched to "float" voltage.

"Float" or "Stand-By" Service: Hold battery across constant voltage source of 13.5 to 13.8 volts continuously. When held at this voltage, the battery will seek its own current level and maintain itself in a fully charged condition.


Note: Due to the self-discharge characteristics of this type of battery, it is imperative that they be charged within 6 months of storage, otherwise permanent loss of capacity might occur as a result of sulfation.


