



Currently LCEC has 170,000 customers without power. There are approximately 45,000 customers that DO have power.

HOW SOON WILL POWER BE RESTORED?

- After a storm has passed, utilities assess the damage to the electric system.
- LCEC then begins restoring power to essential services such as hospitals, traffic signals, shelters, communication centers and law enforcement.
- Next, power is restored to the greatest number of customers in the least amount of time by repairing main circuits.
 - The feeders to neighborhoods.
- Finally, individual services or services that need to be reconnected after repair to the customer's damaged electrical system are restored.
