Update from Lee County Solid Waste:

Lee County Solid waste collection routes will resume for normally scheduled Wednesday routes in all Lee County Franchise areas where the area is accessible to the collection trucks. This includes only household garbage – not recycling and not hurricane debris. Household garbage should be bagged and containerized not exceeding 50 pounds.

The Waste to Energy Facility in Buckingham is open to all customers effective tomorrow.
