Fort Myers, FL, June 21, 2016 — Lee County Utilities' customers received water that met or exceeded all federal and state requirements last year, according to a recent report that has been placed online. The 2015 Water Quality Report can be found at www.leewaterquality.com.

The report, which also includes information such as source water assessments and service areas, is required annually by the Environmental Protection Agency. To save ratepayers money, the annual water-quality report can be placed online instead of direct-mailing customers, according to federal regulations.
