**Precautionary Boil Water Notice lifted for south Fort Myers neighborhoods**

*Neighborhoods along Winkler Road from Banyan Bay to Woodgate Drive can resume normal use*

Fort Myers, FL, May 17, 2024 – Lee County Utilities has rescinded a precautionary Boil Water Notice to an estimated 580 residences in South Fort Myers off Winkler Road.

Bacterial testing has shown the drinking water is safe and residents may now resume usual use of their water without the need to boil it.

The precautionary notice had been in place since Tuesday, May 14. Utility service was interrupted due to a contractor hitting a water main.
