SECTION I - SAFETY

The Applicant agrees to provide adequate traffic and crowd control, emergency medical services and any other items, at the Applicant's expense, required by Lee County to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. Lee County shall have the power to review the proposal and require, as necessary, detailed plans, diagrams, and explanations to clearly outline to Lee County, exactly what the Applicant is proposing.

SECTION II - INSURANCE

The Applicant, at its sole expense, agrees to procure and maintain in force during the entire term of the application, liability insurance in the amounts determined by Lee County Risk Management to protect against damages or other claims arising from use of County property by the applicant or its guests. Other limits may also be established by Lee County Risk Management for events which will be serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at approved County property. The insurance policy must also include coverage for Applicant's contingent liability on damages, claims or losses. "Lee County Board of County Commissioners" must be named as "additional insured" on the Certificate of Insurance, and the Certificate must be delivered to Lee County prior to Applicant's use of the property. The Insurance may not be canceled during the term of the event, if this occurs, the County has the right to revoke approvals related to use of the County property for the event, without recourse by the applicant.

SECTION III - INDEMNIFICATION

The Applicant agrees to indemnify, release and save harmless Lee County against any and all claims, costs, demands, damages, judgments or injuries of any nature arising from the conduct or management of, or from any work or thing whatsoever done in or about said Lee County property or any building or structure appurtenant thereto or equipment thereof during the term of this Permit, or arising during such term from any act of negligence of the Applicant, Applicant's agents, contractors, or employees, or arising from any accident, injury, or damage whatsoever, however caused, to any person or persons, or to any property of any person, persons, corporation or corporations, occurring during the term of this agreement on, in, or about said Lee County property, and from and against all costs, attorney's fees, expenses and liabilities occurring in connection with any such claim or any action or proceeding brought thereon.

For film permit applicants: The permittee shall have on-site a responsible representative empowered with authority over the filming director, filming crews, participants and filming operation. Permittee shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the county, its officers, agents and employees from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, liabilities, expenditures or causes of action of any kind arising out of or occurring during the activities of the permittee, and resulting or occurring from any negligent act, omission or error of permittee, resulting in or relating to injuries to body, life, limb or property sustained in, about or upon the permitted premises or improvement thereto, or arising from the use of the premises.

SECTION IV - DELIVERY, ACCEPTANCE AND SURRENDER OF PREMISES

The Applicant agrees to accept the County property on possession as being in a satisfactory state of repair and in sanitary condition.

The Applicant must surrender the premises to Lee County in the same condition as when Applicant takes possession, allowing for reasonable use and wear, and damage by acts of God. Applicant agrees to remove all business signs or symbols placed on the premises by the Applicant before redelivery of the premises to Lee County, and restore the premises to the condition in which it existed before their placement. Any signs and markings created or used in connection with this event must be temporary and removable; painting roadways, trees or any other fixed object is strictly prohibited. Applicant agrees to clear the Lee County property of litter at the close of the event.

SECTION V - AGREEMENT

The Applicant agrees that Lee County can, at its sole discretion, terminate and cancel its permit to use Lee County property at any time without prejudice. Applicant further agrees to waive, release, save and hold harmless Lee County from any and all claims, demands or cause of actions based upon Lee County's cancellation or termination of said permit.

The Applicant agrees that the Lee County permit does not provide Applicant with any property rights in the County property in question or in the permit itself.

the other like there normally is and the turnaround ability is very limited. Failure to comply may result in creating a public safety hazard.

Promoter/vendor will be responsible for renting light plants to be set up throughout the entire event area including the car show and concert viewing areas. A map of suggested placement will be furnished to the promoter/vendor. No less than **Two** of the light plants must be placed at each entrance near the roadway for LCSO use. LCSO will NOT be out directing traffic without the light plants. **A copy of the rental agreement must be sent to LCSO by March 31, 2023.**

Deputies (How Many):

In addition to the 28 licensed, private security officers being hired through Global Security, the promoter/vendor will be responsible for hiring LCSO detail deputies and will incur the cost. The only changes that will be made to the manpower requirements would be if changes to the venue and parking are made and these changes would be to add additional manpower, not take away.

Staffing for this event has been based on the needs for the event as well as the requirements of the Red Sox and Lee County Parks and Recreations for the safety and security of all involved.

Detail staffing:

- 1 Incident Commander 11a-12a
- 1 Safety Officer 11a-12a
- 1 Traffic Supervisor 11a-12a
- 12 Traffic Deputies 11a-12a (2 MCC1 operators will be a part of this)
- 3 Security Supervisors (one from 11a-12a & two from 1p-12a)
- 24 security deputies (six from 11a-12a and eighteen from 1p-12a)

A Command Post will be established in an area that is deemed safe to do so in. LCSO, Public Safety, and Global Security will all require a designated parking area away from the public. An LCSO Incident Commander and Safety Officer are required to maintain a unified command between public safety entities, private security, venue supervisors and event coordinators. The LCSO IC will be responsible for putting together an Incident Action Plan for Public Safety use prior to the event and ensuring that LCSO supervisors are aware of the mission for the detail. The Safety Officer will be designated to be the liaison between the LCSO IC, LCSO Supervisors, Public Safety, Global Security, venue staff, and event promoter/vendor.

LCSO will not be permitted to be posted in VIP area, backstage/dressing rooms or suites, anywhere artists are gathering.

LCSO will not be permitted to do bag checks or metal detection.

After review, the Lee County Sheriff's Office is signing this permit application based on the events as they are outlined within this application. Any deviations from the plans after this application is signed off upon must be submitted in writing prior to the event and agreed upon between all entities involved in this process. Deviations to the permit may result in additional manpower and equipment being required. The manpower and equipment listed on this application is at the event coordinators expense.

Parking:

All parking will be in authorized areas only. The right-of-way throughout the event area will not be impeded. Event traffic is not permitted to block or impede the roadways around the venue and create a public safety hazard. LCSO detail deputies will be on site to monitor this and if it is deemed a hazard, the event may be shut down in an effort to mitigate the hazard.

Promoter/vendor will bear all responsibility for ensuring that there is ample enough parking to match the ticket sales.

Promoter/vendor will be responsible for ensuring that a car count upon entry to all parking areas is maintained so that parking does not go over capacity. It is incumbent upon the promoter/vendor to accurately articulate the parking information to LCSO. If parking becomes full, the gates to stadium may be required to be shut and participants will be turned away regardless of ticket status.

Promoter/vendor has designated VIP parking and GA parking on their most updated map and will be responsible for renting message boards and for putting up all other signage directing people to the correct parking areas. With the event taking up the middle parcel, there will be no access for vehicles to get from one side of the park to

LCSO will not be posted inside the concert viewing event area.

Promoter/vendor will be responsible for assigning a liaison on the day of the event so that Public Safety, Global Security, and venue staff have **one** representative from Full Throttle Productions that they all can remain available for contact with throughout the event.

Fee for Service:

Fee for service will be included in an estimate provided to promoter/vendor.

Promoter/vendor will be responsible for signing all detail paperwork and returning it immediately and for paying for the detail in full prior to the start of the event.

Payment can only be made in the form of a cashier's check made out to LCSO and brought to HQ no later than March 31, 2023. Cash, business checks, money orders and credit card payments will not be accepted and the balance must be paid in full. If the detail ends early, the LCSO staff will bill out for whatever was worked and a refund will be sent. Failure to sign and return detail paperwork and to pay for the detail by the date listed, will result in contact to Lee County entities to notify them of non-compliance.

Special Arrangements:

Promoter/vendor is responsible for ensuring that all of the authorization for land use is included in the final packet to include a separate approval to use all Parks & Rec parcels involved in this event. The letter must specifically outline the use of both the Red Sox and Parks and Recreation parcels to show exclusive use of the property by Full Throttle Productions for the day.

Promoter/vendor will be responsible for monitoring all amplified sound throughout the entire event to ensure that it does not exceed the decibel levels set forth by Lee County Noise Ordinance Chapter 24 ¼.

Promoter/vendor will be responsible for clearly cordoning off the event area to maintain a safe, vehicle free area for pedestrians and spectators to be in. The area needs to be clearly designated through the use of fencing, barricades, cones, etc. and this will all be done at the vendor's expense.

- 2) 4 portable toilet units will be required: 2 to be placed at the West end and 2 placed at the East end of VIP parking at Power Alley lot for the duration of the permit: delivered on 4/5 and removed 4/10.
- 3) All participants and spectators must disperse and leave the event area to seek safe shelter in their vehicles during lightning alerts and threatening weather.

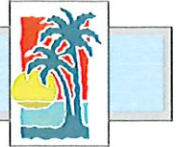
