Studies on file: August 16, 2019 email request from resident on Wakefield Drive. With the posting of a No Thru Trucks restriction on July 10, 2019 (Traffic Regulation Order No. 1,037) on Southwell Drive, based on resident complaints with commercial vehicle traffic, it appears that some commercial vehicle operators have diverted to the only other east-west road into the subdivision off of Plantation Road, that being Wakefield Drive. It is reasonable to acknowledge that some diverted commercial vehicle traffic may be occurring. To mitigate this condition, it is appropriate to prohibit the commercial vehicle use of this local residential street.
