The organizations inside the Target Community are Gulf Coast Humane Society, Spay Lee, PAWS, ARC, Helping Paws and Golden Retriever Rescue. The statistics listed are the best estimates possible based on our numbers and veterinary examinations at LCDAS. The ASILOMAR ACCORDS method of outcoming was instituted in February 2015. With regards to the Ending Count, the intake in our system also takes into account animals born in the shelter and DOA at intake. The Ending County does not take into consideration those animals on hold through the beginning and end of the year and the discrepancy calculated may reflect these animals.
