Fort Myers, FL, Dec. 30, 2025 – Lee County Domestic Animal Services kicks off the New Year – or “barks in the mew year” – with adoption fees reduced to \$25 for all cats, kittens and adult dogs through the month of January.

Every adoption through Lee County Domestic Animal Services includes a comprehensive adoption package to ensure pets and their new families get off to a great start:

- Spay or neuter surgery
- Age-appropriate vaccinations
- Microchip and registration
- Rabies vaccination (for pets of appropriate age)
- Free health check at the time of adoption

The Pet Adoption Center will be closed Thursday, Jan. 1, and Friday, Jan. 2. Normal hours resume Saturday, Jan. 3.
