I. SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

Adoption of a County Ordinance amending Lee County Ordinance No. 08-15, (the Charter), by incorporating the Boards proposed amendment relating to term limits for Lee County Constitutional Officers, and as may be approved by the electorate in a Special Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.
