Florida and one of only 28 in the entire United States and

Whereas: The Charlotte Harbor National Estuary Program, a partnership of citizens,

elected officials, resource managers and commercial and recreational resource users who are working to improve the water quality and ecological integrity of the Greater Charlotte Harbor Watershed, jointly developed and approved a Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan for the Charlotte Harbor

Watershed in February 2000; and

Whereas: Estuaries are unique environments where rivers meet the sea, are vital
