#### **Detailed Rate Proposal**

In addition to providing an option to recycle 100% of the horticulture waste brought into Lee County's Yard Waste (Horticulture) Processing and Recycling Facility, D. J. Casey Enterprises envisions future opportunities to combine its recycling efforts to include other waste streams such as sludge wastes and other wastes including food, fruit, and vegetables. Currently, disposal of these waste streams cause concern. However, when handled properly and mixed with horticulture wastes, these biosolid waste materials actually compliment one another thereby creating a "super compost".

For the purposes of this Proposal, D. J. Casey Enterprises offers the following two scenarios for continuing the County's horticulture operations ...

#### **BASIC PROPOSAL -**

D. J. Casey Enterprises proposes to operate the County's facility in the manner prescribed in the Request for Proposal. As a side note, we noted that the County's proposal is very similar to the City's Horticulture Reduction & Recycling Facility at 2451 Arcadia Street — which we are currently managing and which will be closed once the County's facility is opened.

Specifically, our understanding of the County's proposal is for the "Provider" to receive all incoming yard waste (horticulture) materials at the County's WTE Facility on Buckingham. The Provider will inspect (reject), stockpile, sort (debag/dispose), grind, screen, load, haul, recycle and/or sell to an end user. This scenario provides for a flat rate for the services being provided. The proposed flat rate under this proposal is \$14.58\* per ton based on outgoing (processed) materials.

This price includes a performance bond in the amount of \$200,000.

#### RECYCLING OTHER WASTE ITEMS (i.e. Biosolids) -

When it comes to solid waste, Lee County is ahead of their time as compared to other counties in the State of Florida and other states in the Nation. However, when it comes to recycling, Lee County, the State of Florida, and the Nation as a whole are not keeping up with most of the civilized World. There are some very easy and basic ways to recycle several waste types.

Based on our operating experience, and our research and development, we believe that further recycling is a natural fit for combining biosolids with horticulture wastes to produce superior compost mixes. We are very interested in pioneering Lee County's biosolid recycling program — to do just that, recycle sludge and food wastes along with horticulture wastes — similar to those already being utilized in other counties in Florida; not to mention other parts of the World.

We at D. J. Casey Enterprises have been working with the University of Florida's Cooperative Extension Service researching the use of composts for citrus and other farming operations in addition to landscape and development uses. What we have found is that there is a need for good quality compost to enhance plant growth and product yield. We recommend that the County work with us to find ways of recycling these and other types of wastes.

Also, the County has many departments that need clean material for landscaping, repairing wash-out areas, installing berms, site grading, park and common area enhancement/maintenance; all end-uses for the recycled compost products. We would propose to work with these departments to identify how our products could benefit them while saving money and natural resources.

Of course, another option would be for D. J. Casey Enterprises to help the county set up its own compost facility ... perhaps on the City's property known as "Section 30". Here the County could negotiate with the City to lease the property (site of old landfill) and begin recycling its own wastes over time. D. J. Casey Enterprises could consult and market the products being produced.

As you can see there are many possibilities for recycling wastes. We would like to be of service to the county and look forward to a long and lasting relationship.

#### **Operating Hours**

As previously stated, D. J. Casey Enterprises would staff the facility at all times during the operating hours of the facility with a front-end loader operator and any labor necessary to stockpile and/or pick bags at all times.

Any operating hours necessary due to being "on-call" would also be staffed with consideration given for reasonable notice (i.e. 12 hours).

During times of emergency, the Company will assist the City in around-the-clock operations as necessary to meet the needs of the residents.
