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Per Section 6 of the Contracts Manual for annual type master contracts the Board can concur with the selection of consultants and authorize staff to negotiate hourly rates and independent cost within the same blue sheet request. This will eliminate the need for an additional blue sheet requesting Board approval of agreements.

Because of the large amount and variety of miscellaneous professional services expected to be needed and because many projects may require various professional services during the same period of time, the Committee agreed that the County's interests will be served best by developing Professional Services Agreements with several consulting firms. Accordingly, the Committee recommends that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Committee to negotiate two year contracts with the eighteen (18) firms to provide Miscellaneous Professional Services on a project-by-project basis with work assignments confirmed, authorized and accounted for by the issuance of Supplemental Task Authorizations.

Funds will be available within specific project budgets.
