TIME REQUIRED: 7. BACKGROUND:										
At the February 10 th BOCC meeting, DOT brought back the eight (8) design options for the Sanibel Bridge superstructure, Span A, as had been previously requested by the Board. The BOCC narrowed the selection down to a total of four (4) designs and asked that it be brought back to the BOCC at the March 9 th meeting, along with an estimate of the toll that would be required for each of the designs. Attached are the digital photos of the four (4) bridge designs, along with the updated information from the News Press poll and a spreadsheet showing the approximate toll required to support the construct costs for each of the options.										
Originally, the BOCC requested that DOT staff pursue a unique or beautiful design for the replacement for the Sanibel Causeway Bridge Structures. The direction was that the design had to be such that the structure could be built within the existing budget and within the existing schedule. To accomplish this task, DOT asked the RLAC to help organize this effort. The RLAC set up a technical subcommittee to seek public input as to the possible types of design.
