

FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN

LEE COUNTY AND CITY OF BONITA SPRINGS FOR BEACH AND BAY PARK NORTH ON HICKORY ISLAND

This First Amendment to that certain Interlocal Agreement between Lee County and the City of Bonita Springs regarding Beach Park North on Hickory Island is made and entered in this 2nd day of December, 2003 is made this _____ of 2004, by and between the City of Bonita Springs, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida acting by and through its City Council, the governing body thereof, "City" and Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, the governing body thereof, "County", collectively, the "parties" hereto.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties previously entered into the Interlocal Agreement regarding Beach Park North on Hickory Island on December 2, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend the Interlocal Agreement to add the parcel of property ("Bay Park North") located across Little Hickory Boulevard as an additional park amenity with a boat ramp under the same terms as Beach Park North.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and of mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, the City and the County, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree to this First Amendment, as follows:

- 1. The recitals as set forth above are incorporated into the terms of this agreement as if set out herein at length.
- 2. Section One, Purpose, is hereby amended as follows:

It is the purpose and intent of this Agreement to define the terms and conditions for the City to operate and maintain the small parcel which is across the road from Public Beach Access Number 10 ("Beach Park North") and the small boat access across Hickory Boulevard ("Bay Park North"), both parcels located within the corporate limits of the City of Bonita Springs and utilized by both residents and visitors of Bonita Springs. The City of Bonita Springs will maintain the boat ramp at Bay Park North to allow accessibility by boaters to the Gulf of Mexico and Estero Bay.

All terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be interpreted in a manner consistent with, and furtherance, the purpose as set forth in this paragraph.

3. Section Three, Management, Operation and Use of the Right-of-Way Property, is amended by adding Exhibit "B" for Bay Park North, describing the cost of construction, initial landscaping and maintenance of the enhanced level of services and by adding a

revised Exhibit "C" for Bay Park North, describing improvements to said property, in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by City and County

4. Section Four, Permits, is hereby amended as follows:

City will obtain all permitting necessary to create the beach <u>and bay</u> park improvements.

5. Section Five, Maintenance, is hereby amended as follows:

City agrees to maintain the beach and bay park improvements and enhanced level landscaping and other items of the improvements, which may include items incidental to landscaping, including and irrigation system and replacement of dead sod or plant materials. City agrees to keep the property free of hazards and obstructions.

6. Section Eight: Term of Interlocal Agreement, is hereby amended as follows:

This Interlocal Agreement shall be deemed effective as of December 1, 2003, with its execution by both parties, and will remain in full force and effect until September 30, 2053. The Agreement will continue in full force and effect unless at such time that the road is closed, abandoned, vacated, discontinued, or reconstructed, or for Bay Park North in the event that the land is necessary for the realignment of the existing bridge, or until the City receives the written notice of the County's termination of this Agreement after September 30, 2053.

- 7. All other terms of the Interlocal Agreement remain the same.
- 8. This Interlocal Agreement shall become effective on the date written above. This Agreement, and any subsequent Amendments thereto, shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Lee County.

Bay Park North

This project was recently initiated by the City Council, but had not been specifically listed in he City's 5-year CIP. In order to provide funding, you requested that I attempt to estimate the cost of engineering and construction. Please understand that the construction cost estimates are quite conceptual at this time, based only on verbal discussions, since "concept drawings" are not even available at this time.

The project involves site clearing and removal of exotic vegetation, reconstruction of an existing boat ramp, providing a paved drive and vehicle and boat trailer parking, sodding and landscaping, and an irrigation system.

The costs are now estimated as follows:

Surveying, Engineering, Permitting & Related	\$ 24,000

Clearing of Site, including debris & "exotic" vegetation	\$ 6,000
Construction of driveway, boat ramp, boat trailer/vehicle parking area, water retention facility, landscaping, sprinkler system, signage	\$100,000

Estimated Project Cost	\$130,000

If Council approves the engineering on February 4, 2004, I would estimate that the design work would be completed by May 1, 2004, with permitting completed by June 1, 2004. If we open bids on approximately June 1, conceivably construction might start July 1, with completion by approximately September 1, 2004. Again, the dates are somewhat "fluid" at this time, but I would expect final completion yet this fiscal year.
