7. BACKGROUND: Babcock Ranch is located in Lee and Charlotte Counties. Lee County has taken the lead in forming a										
coalition of partners interested in purchasing Babcock Ranch to ensure it stays in its natural resource condition. Conservation										
20/20 is the County lead program for such participation. The program has certain requirements that must be met, including										
public access and willing seller. Participation in the partnership may require the County to consider actions not common										
under 20/20, such as a dollar or percentage commitment of 20/20 funds to a multiyear buy out, or participation in voluntary										
actions such as voluntary condemnation which provides the seller tax advantages. CLASAC will be requested to discuss the										
advantages and disadvantages of approaches applicable to Babcock, and to identify if any changes are needed to implementing ordinances, if such are needed to pursue a desirable purchase arrangement.
