with spoken and written language, while the animals we care for cannot, and thus it our responsibility to guarantee our companion pets a voice if

they become lost or separated from us; and

Whereas: Providing identification in the form of an ID tag, County license or

registered permanent microchip ID is the only way to give our companions

that voice when they are lost or separated; and

Whereas: Nearly all animals that enter our public shelter with proper identification

are reunited with their owners in a very timely manuer; compared to only one in four dogs and one in fifty cats that are reunited with their owners

when they have no identification.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of County Commissioners of

Lee County, Florida hereby declares that "Every Day is Tag Day in Lee County" in recognition of the national campaign for animal identification; and encourages our pet owners to identify their animals with Microchip

IDs and a County License Tag.
