9. Background:

In past Legislative Sessions, Ms. Bleakley has assisted the County from the legal consulting perspective on certain, identified matters that required a Tallahassee legal presence in order to make Lee County's legal positions known on Bills being presented during the Legislative Session.

This Session appears to be no exception, and Ms. Bleakley's services are desired by staff to enhance Lee County's esence in Tallahassee on certain matters.

The Nabors, Giblin proposal letter of March 23, 2005 quotes a fixed fee of \$20,00000 for their services for the duration of the Legislative Session. The Nabors, Giblin legal services will be paid for by the County Attorney's Office.

Ms. Bleakley has been instructed to coordinate with Keith Arnold so that our legal and lobbying services will be complimented and our Tallahassee presence enhanced.

As stated in her March 23, 2005 proposal letter, Ms. Bleakley will be monitoring the present Bills relating to impact fees, communication towers, solid waste matters and the water reservations Legislation. We may also ask her to assist with the several new Growth Management Bills and other technical/legal issues as they may arise during the balance of the Session.

Dear David:

As you have requested, this letter presents a proposal for our firm to provide special legal consulting services to Lee County Board of County Commissioners for the 2005 Regular Session, and any extended or special session as may be deemed necessary.

It is our understanding that the County desires advice and special legal assistance on several local issues that are under consideration in the Legislature. To assist the County, we propose to provide the special legal consultant services as directed by you on issues of interest to the County including, but not limited to, impact fee restrictions, communication tower legislation, solid waste amendments and the water reservation legislation.

As to compensation for our services during the Regular Session, which commenced March 8, 2005, we suggest a flat fee of \$20,000, inclusive of expenses. The suggested flat fee is intended to cover the anticipated time required in addressing the multiplicity and complexity of the issues contemplated in the County's legislative program.

We propose to bill the County in four equal installments. The first will be mailed upon receiving Board approval of the terms for our services. The final three installments on the fifteenth of the succeeding months thereafter (April 15, May 15, and June 15).

It has been with great professional satisfaction that we have served Lee County through the provision of special legal consulting services in past Session. We anticipate that the challenge presented by the difficult and complex issues on the County's 2005 legislative program will prove equally rewarding.
