9. Background:

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for the project known as CN-06-01 Renovations to the Wachovia 2nd Floor for the Lee County Supervisor of Elections, and Renovations to the Lee County Constitutional Complex for the Lee County Property Appraiser.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was November 8, 2005. A total of five (5) letters of Interest were received by the established deadline. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of the following staff members: Jim Lavender, Public Works Director, Chairperson, Daniel Cruz, Project Manager and Rich Beck, Facilities Management. On the basis of the information submitted by the five (5) firms in their Letters of Interest, it was the consensus of the committee to invite three (3) firms for interviews/presentation: PBS&J, Parker/Mudgett/Smith Architects and RS&H.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in their Letters of Interest and after conducting the interviews/presentations on November 18, 2005, with the "short list" firms, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Board the following order of ranking of Consultants: 1) Parker/Mudgett/Smith Architects.: 2) RS&H. 3) PBS&J.

The negotiated agreement with the number-one ranked firm will be brought back to the Board for their approval.

Budget has not been established for this project. An estimated \$3 million will be requested from reserves when the renovation costs are established.
