9. Background:

Parks and Recreation received the attached letter from Boylan Environmental Consultants, Inc. requesting use of Caloosahatchee Regional Park for wetland mitigation for Sunrise Lakes, a private development. Mitigation work at Caloosahatchee Regional Park includes removal of 9.3 acres of Brazilian pepper; re-grade berm and installation of native vegetation, without any cost to Lee County. This mitigation work is compatible with the long-term goal of removing all exotic vegetation from Caloosahatchee Regional Park and improving wildlife habitat along Fichter's Creek. This project allows Parks and Recreation and Boylan Environement to present the mitigation project to South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) for approval and receive funding for a project that Parks and Recreation will supervise.

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
## RESOLUTION#
