9. Background: On August 29, 2006 the Affordable Housing Committee voted to update and expand the study titled "The public costs of inadequate affordable housing in Lee County, Florida" by Deborah Halliday MPA published in 2002. The original document focuses on the impact of inadequate affordable housing for very low and low income households. The Committee voted to recommend updating and expanding this study to include moderate income households.

An update of the 2002 study would cost \$32,000. The cost to expand the study would be more, but is not determined at this time. The expansion may require primary research, which would affect project cost. (Primary research may be required because demographic and economic information for moderate income households is not as readily available as that for very low and low income households.) There are two options:

Option 1: Update the study entitled "The public costs of inadequate affordable housing in Lee County, Florida" prepared by Deborah Halliday MPA and published in September 2002. The cost would be \$32,000.

Once the cost and the project scope are identified for expanding the document, this information could be brought back for discussion to the Affordable Housing Committee.

Option 2: Do not update the study because the need for affordable housing has been established.

Staff recommends updating the 2002 study. This study quantifies the costs of not providing affordable housing. Affordable housing providers have used this study to obtain grant funding and bankers have used it as a basis for evaluating affordable housing initiatives.
