## LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 25-05-05 EXTENSION OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY COUNTYWIDE

WHEREAS, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 24-208 on September 23, 2024, and Amended Executive Order Number 24-209 on September 24, 2024, declaring a State of Emergency for the State of Florida for sixty (60) days in anticipation of Hurricane Helene; and

WHEREAS, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 25-102 on May 14, 2025, extending Executive Order Number 24-208, as amended by Executive Order Number 24-209, and subsequently extended by Executive Order Number 24-249 (issued on November 21, 2024), Executive Order Number 25-10 (issued on January 17, 2025), and Executive Order Number 25-57 (issued on March 17, 2025) to renew the State of Emergency for the State of Florida for sixty (60) days, because recovery efforts and those affected by this disaster require continued support of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida declared a State of Local Emergency on September 24, 2024, in anticipation of the impacts of Hurricane Helene, Emergency Resolution No. 24-09-52, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and Lee County Ordinance 87-01; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 252.38(3)(a)(5) provides authority for political subdivisions to declare a State of Local Emergency and to waive the procedures and formalities otherwise required of political subdivisions in order to take whatever action is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 252 of the Florida Statutes limits the duration of each State of Local Emergency to seven (7) days and it may be extended, as necessary, for additional terms in seven (7) day increments; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Resolution No. 24-09-52, as subsequently extended by

Resolution No. 25-05-03, expires on May 20, 2025, unless extended; and

WHEREAS, an extension of Emergency Resolution No. 24-09-52 is necessary

because Hurricane Helene has caused personal injury and extensive damage to

commercial, residential, and public structures of Lee County; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the effects of Hurricane Helene continue to pose a serious threat to the lives

and property of the residents of Lee County and that an extension of a State of

Local Emergency is declared, effective immediately for all unincorporated and

incorporated areas within the local boundaries of Lee County, Florida.

2. The Resolution No. 24-09-52 Declaring a State of Local Emergency is hereby

extended for an additional seven (7) day increment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby exercises

its authority and waives the procedures and formalities required by law of a political

subdivision, as authorized under §252.38, Florida Statutes.
