

Redistricting – What, Why & How?

Definition

The process by which a legislative body equalizes differences in the population of districts by making adjustments to district boundaries.

Guiding Legislation

- FL Constitution Article VIII, Section 1(e)
- Chapter 124.01(3), F.S.
- Lee County's Home Rule Charter, Section 2.2

Additional Principles

- 14th Amendment (1868)
- 15th Amendment (1870)
- Voting Rights Act (1965)






