Lee County operations adjust schedules for Thanksgiving

Fort Myers, FL, Nov. 23, 2015 — Most Lee County administrative operations will be closed Thursday, Nov. 26, and Friday, Nov. 27, in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday. Other schedules will be adjusted.

The adjustments include:

Solid Waste

- Thursday, Nov. 26: All county facilities are closed and no trash will be collected.
- Friday, Nov. 27: Thursday collections will be picked up. The Waste to Energy Facility in Buckingham will be open regular hours to accept waste. The Topaz Court Solid Waste annex facility will be closed.
- Saturday, Nov. 28: Friday collections will be picked up. The Buckingham facility will be open until 5 p.m. to accept waste. The Topaz facility will be closed.

LeeTran

- Thursday, Nov. 26: No bus or Passport service.
- Friday, Nov. 27: Normal service resumes.

Parks & Recreation

- Thursday, Nov. 26, Friday, Nov. 27 and through the holiday weekend: Beaches, boat ramps, parks and preserves will be open.
- Administration offices, pools and recreation centers are closed Thursday, Nov. 26, and Friday, Nov. 27. Recreation centers and pools resume normal operating hours Saturday, Nov. 28. Administration offices resume normal operating hours Monday, Nov. 30.

Library System

- Wednesday, Nov. 25: Libraries close at 5 p.m.
- Thursday, Nov. 26, and Friday, Nov. 27: All libraries will be closed.
- Saturday, Nov. 28: Libraries open for regular hours.

Domestic Animal Services

- Thursday, Nov. 26, and Friday, Nov. 27: The shelter, 5600 Banner Drive in South Fort Myers, will be closed.
- Saturday, Nov. 28: The Lost & Found Pet Center will reopen for regular hours at 8 a.m. and the adoption center will open at 10:30 a.m.
