Executive Summary

Community Aid

- Through November of 2020 the County has disbursed over \$40 million in community aid through the LeeCARES program in the forms of rent, mortgage and utility payment assistance, business grants, PPE distribution, food supplies, childcare scholarships and COVID-19 testing. An additional \$10 million of assistance has been obligated and payment is pending.
- \$14,000,000 of additional community aid is projected through year-end to put the total amount over \$60,000,000 (see Slide 3). Note: this amount does not include housing assistance offered through other County programs.

Government Expenses

- Lee County is also reimbursing some units of local government for COVID-19 response expenditures:
 - Board of County Commissioners operating departments
 - Lee County Sheriff's Office
 - Clerk of Courts, Tax Collector, Medical Examiner
 - Municipalities (Bonita Springs, Cape Coral, Estero, Fort Myers, Fort Myers Beach, Sanibel)
 - Independent Fire Districts (17 separate districts)

CARES Act funding expires on December 30, 2020. Coronavirus Relief Fund direct allocation expenditures are projected to reach \$134,459,744.










