

Disaster Recovery Permitting Requirements

The Record Types currently being accepted, only if related to hurricane damage, and the requirements for each has been outlined below. Please be prepared to provide all necessary documentation for a full review to be completed.

BUILDING PERMITS:

- Alteration / Remodel (Interior and Exterior)
Note: For Primary Commercial Buildings, Modular Buildings, Residential Dwellings, and Mobile Home/RVs only
 - Floor Plan
 - Detailed Scope of Work
 - FL or NOA Product Approval Numbers
 - Clarify if any structural damage
- Exterior Openings (Windows/Doors/Shutters)
 - Floor Plan ([click here for an example layout](#))
 - FL or NOA Product Approval Numbers
 - Sealed pressures if building is over 60' in height (Commercial Only)
- Fire
 - Floor Plan
 - Detailed Scope of Work
 - Signed & sealed plans if Commercial, and over 249 sprinkler heads
- Mechanical, Electrical, or Plumbing (may require Plan Review)
 - Floor Plan
 - Detailed Scope of Work
 - Note: Electrical – Services Changes/Service Repairs accepted, regardless of Hurricane Damage.*
- Other Commercial Types (i.e. Antennae, Lift Stations, Water Well, Concrete/Foundation, etc.)
 - Signed and sealed letter may suffice for any structural repairs
- Roof
 - FL or NOA Product Approval Numbers
 - If over \$300,000 - Letter from CGC, CBC, CRC to address attachments
- Roofover
 - Floor Plan
 - Detailed Scope of Work,
 - FL or NOA Product Approval Numbers
- Solar
 - Layout showing panel locations
 - Detailed Scope of Work

 - Replacement Wells
 - Public Water Supply Improvements
