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

# AGREEMENT BETWEEN LEE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION AND KIWANIS CLUB OF RIVERDALE- LEE COUNTY INC. MEDIEVAL FAIRE AT LAKES REGIONAL PARK

This Agreement is entered into by and between Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida whose mailing address is Post Office Box 398, Fort Myers, Florida 33902, by and through Lee County Parks and Recreation (County); and Kiwanis Club of Riverdale – Lee County, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation whose mailing address is Post Office Box 50376, Fort Myers, Florida 33905 (Kiwanis) who agree as follows:

The County and the Kiwanis agree to permit a Medieval Faire at Lakes Regional Park for two consecutive weekends, which are January 7, 8, 14, and 15, 2017 pending the approval of the Use of County Property Special Events permit to be submitted by the Kiwanis. The Kiwanis must obtain an approved Permit to Sell and Consume Alcoholic Beverages Permit if beer and wine are to be allowed. A copy of the fully executed and approved permits must be given to Parks and Recreation a minimum of one week prior to the event (ie. no later than December 27, 2016). Failure to provide the approved permits will result in cancellation of the event.

- 1. Concept. The County agrees that the Lee County Medieval Faire (Faire) is a product and concept of the Kiwanis of Riverdale (aka Kiwanis Club of Riverdale-Lee County, Inc.). The event in no way gives the County rights to produce, or use its concept, except in conjunction with the Kiwanis.
- 2. **Set up and Breakdown dates.** The Kiwanis will set up the Faire beginning on Tuesday, January 3, 2017. The Kiwanis, because of the event running through two weekends, will take down and remove all easily damaged props during the weekdays between the event weekends. All large items such as the main ticket booth, castle wall, primary stages, etc. will be left intact, onsite, but may not block any paths, trails, roads, etc. The County will assist where possible. The Kiwanis will completely vacate and return in good condition the property used during the Faire no later than Wednesday, January 18, 2017 at 12:00 noon.
- 3. Park Walkthroughs. A thorough walk through of the park site must be made one week before the event with the site Supervisor to photo document the condition of the facility. All documentation of the condition of the park must be signed off by the County and User Event Coordinator. A Kiwanis representative must be available immediately the next day after closing to image document the condition of the facility and again when all features/equipment have been removed. Any damages caused as a result of the Kiwanis' event will be the responsibility of the Kiwanis to repair or replace at the Kiwanis' expense. Failure to compensate the County for any damages may result in future use of the facility being denied.

- 4. **Event Area; Parking.** The Faire will close an agreed upon portion of Lakes Regional Park to all vehicular traffic and pedestrian traffic except for Medieval Faire participants, vendors (which the Kiwanis will monitor) and the Kiwanis will be responsible to direct and control onsite parking at Lakes Regional Park during the Faire times from 5:00 PM, Friday, January 6, 2017 through 11:00 PM, Sunday, January 8<sup>th</sup> and again at 5:00 PM, Friday, January 13, 2017 through 11:00 PM, Sunday, January 15, 2017. Kiwanis will provide all necessary temporary fencing and barriers to close the Faire area as well as staff to control and direct parking within Lakes Park. The County will provide any available County owned temporary fencing and the Kiwanis will be responsible for the remaining temporary fencing.
- 5. **Signage**. The Kiwanis will provide all signage necessary pertaining to the Faire within Lakes Park. The County will provide directional parking signs, if available, on the public roadways.
- 6. Security. The Kiwanis will provide Event security, on Faire grounds and traffic control, beginning within the park entrance and all areas within Lakes Park comprising the Faire site and areas designated for vendor overnight use. This would include a minimum of two Lee County Sheriff's Deputies (or the number of deputies required by the Sheriff's Department on the Special Events Permit) with the assistance of a maximum of three County Rangers (if available), on Faire grounds, during the operational hours of the Faire to make sure that all parts of County Ordinance #06-26 are enforced. No swimming in the Lake.
- Campsite. The Kiwanis will provide for setup and security of a pre-determined 7. County designated campsite for Kiwanis staff. Security for these areas will be required for all nights the campsite is in use and is in addition to security for the vendor areas, which will remain set up Friday and Saturday nights during the event. (This would also include Sundays, if applicable). The campsite area will have tent only areas as well as areas for trailers and RVs. (Camping will only be permitted in the designated camping areas.) Use of County electricity by campers is prohibited unless specifically permitted in writing by the County. No dumping of gray water or waste. No swimming in the lake and no ground fires except in County provided fire ring, conditions permitting. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. The County will not be held responsible or liable for damage, destruction, vandalism, etc. for any Faire props, decorations, etc. at Lakes Park from set up to tear down. The Kiwanis will provide cleanup of camping areas at the end of the event. The designated camping area is off limits to anyone else, the Deputies and Lee County Rangers will assist in enforcing this. Excepting certified service animals acting in a working capacity, NO DOGS OR PETS ARE PERMITTED IN THE PARK OR COMPSITE.. It will be the responsibility of the Kiwanis to first inform all vendors and campers of this policy. KIWANIS WILL BE REQUIRED TO IMMEDIATELY HAVE PETS REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES.
- 8. **Decorations and Site Preparation**. The Kiwanis will provide all decorating and site preparation as needed for the Faire including, but not limited to, marking of the vendor spaces, food and drink locations and amphitheater.

- 9. **Disabled parking**. Parking spaces for the disabled will be provided by the Kiwanis at Lakes Park.
- 10. Ticket Sales. The Kiwanis will provide ticket sales and collections at Lakes Park for persons attending the Faire. The County will provide a money count room and a bill counter for the Kiwanis, if requested by Kiwanis.
- 11. Dumpster; Trash and Portable Restroom Facilities. The County will provide up to three personnel per event day and one dumpster receptacle for garbage pick up at the Faire grounds and personnel services as needed to provide standard services at the Park area. The Kiwanis will provide a minimum of 100 disposable type trash cans for the two event weekends (50 per weekend).

The Kiwanis will provide additional portable toilet facilities with service during the Faire. Standard County services will include cleaning fixed restrooms as needed, picking up ground litter as needed and emptying trash cans as needed.

The Kiwanis will be responsible for bagging and disposing in a provided dumpster any waste located within the Faire grounds and vendor overnight areas a minimum of once daily.

- 12. Bleacher. The County will provide as many bleachers as readily available.
- 13. **Media Materials**. The Kiwanis will be responsible for their own printing services for all Faire related posters, programs, fliers, etc.
- 14. Event Promotion. The County will provide assistance with advertising and promotion where possible.
- 15. Event Coordination. The Kiwanis will contact, contract with, and provide miscellaneous vendors, (including food and drink), entertainment acts, etc. for the Faire. The Kiwanis will be responsible for putting the Faire together completely with all the trappings and be responsible for scheduling, appearances and timing of the entertainment. Alcoholic beverage sales will be allowed if approved in accordance with applicable State and local regulations (i.e. FS s. 561.422; Special Events Permit provisions, LCO 06-26, s. 4.3; and, temporary alcohol permit requirements, LDC 34-1264).
- 16. Entertainer Safety. The Kiwanis will provide and insure that all acts (animal and human) are safe and properly secured from danger or injury to Faire patrons, park visitors and staff.
- 17. Invitees. The Kiwanis will invite those persons whom they feel will enhance the Faire and reserve the right to refuse entrance or appearance to any person who they feel will distract from the Faire or its purpose.

- 18. Community Service. The Kiwanis will coordinate with the Lakes Park Enrichment Foundation to provide volunteer, community service and fund raising opportunities in accord with applicable regulations.
- 19. Animal Acts. The County will allow jousting, petting zoo, animal acts and other displays at the Faire as agreed upon with the County prior to the Faire.
- 20. Fees. The County will receive, from the Kiwanis, a flat fee of \$9,000.00 for the use of the Lakes Park for the Faire (\$9,000.00 fee must be paid in full within 10 days after the closing date of the Faire). There will be a \$25.00 per day late fee charged for non-payment of the entire \$9,000 fee, for each day the fee remains unpaid past the 10 day payment deadline. The County will hold an additional \$1,500.00 refundable deposit for damages. Payment of the damage deposit must be made prior to the event set up and will be refunded all or in part after the event vacates the park and a damage walk through is completed by County staff with Faire staff. Set up will not be permitted until the damage deposit is paid in full to the County.
- 21. **Examination of Records**. The County, at reasonable times, may examine the Kiwanis' event sales records in order to monitor and verify the Faire's receipts. The County may terminate this contract if Kiwanis refuses to permit access for examination.
- 22. Revenue Deposit. All other revenue received by the Faire will be deposited into the Riverdale Kiwanis Project Account. All Kiwanis expenses will be paid from this account.
- 23. **Faire Committee Meetings**. The County will provide employees to attend Faire Committee meetings held by the Kiwanis on a regular basis as a liaison to the County.
- 24. Insurance. The Kiwanis must provide evidence of Commercial General Liability Insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence including coverage for products and completed operations. In addition, Lee County Board of County Commissioners will be listed as additional insured for the date and time of the event. The Kiwanis must provide fully executed permits for Use of County Property and Sales and Consumption of Alcohol at least seven days prior to the event.
- 25. Renewal. Both parties may renew this agreement on an annual basis after review and acceptance.
- 26. Hold Harmless. Kiwanis agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend County and all of its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all claims, actions, damages, and liability cost expense, including those arising from bodily injury, death and/or property damages or any other lawful expense, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees and court costs resulting from any negligent act or omission by Kiwanis, its officers, agents, and employees while acting within the scope of their employment during the duration of the use of the Lakes Regional Park facilities. Neither

County nor any of its officers, agents or employees will be liable under this agreement for claims, actions, damages, and liability cost expense, including those arising from bodily injury, death and/or property damages or any other lawful expense, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees and court costs resulting from the negligence of Kiwanis or any of its officers, agents or employees. This agreement is in accordance with the general laws of the State of Florida and subject to the limitations as set out in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.
