SECTION I - SAFETY

The Applicant agrees to provide adequate traffic and crowd control, emergency medical services and any other items, at the Applicant's expense, required by Lee County to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. Lee County shall have the power to review the proposal and require, as necessary, detailed plans, diagrams, and explanations to clearly outline to Lee County, exactly what the Applicant is proposing.

SECTION II - INSURANCE

The Applicant, at its sole expense, agrees to procure and maintain in force during the entire term of the application, liability insurance in the amounts determined by Lee County Risk Management to protect against damages or other claims arising from use of County property by the applicant or its guests. Other limits may also be established by Lee County Risk Management for events which will be serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at approved County property. The insurance policy must also include coverage for Applicant's contingent liability on damages, claims or losses. "Lee County Board of County Commissioners" must be named as "additional insured" on the Certificate of Insurance, and the Certificate must be delivered to Lee County prior to Applicant's use of the property. The Insurance may not be canceled during the term of the event, if this occurs, the County has the right to revoke approvals related to use of the County property for the event, without recourse by the applicant.

SECTION III - INDEMNIFICATION

The Applicant agrees to indemnify, release and save harmless Lee County against any and all claims, costs, demands, damages, judgments or injuries of any nature arising from the conduct or management of, or from any work or thing whatsoever done in or about said Lee County property or any building or structure appurtenant thereto or equipment thereof during the term of this Permit, or arising during such term from any act of negligence of the Applicant, Applicant's agents, contractors, or employees, or arising from any accident, injury, or damage whatsoever, however caused, to any person or persons, or to any property of any person, persons, corporation or corporations, occurring during the term of this agreement on, in, or about said Lee County property, and from and against all costs, attorney's fees, expenses and liabilities occurring in connection with any such claim or any action or proceeding brought thereon.

For film permit applicants: The permittee shall have on-site a responsible representative empowered with authority over the filming director, filming crews, participants and filming operation. Permittee shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the county, its officers, agents and employees from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, liabilities, expenditures or causes of action of any kind arising out of or occurring during the activities of the permittee, and resulting or occurring from any negligent act, omission or error of permittee, resulting in or relating to injuries to body, life, limb or property sustained in, about or upon the permitted permises or improvement thereto, or arising from the use of the premises.

SECTION IV - DELIVERY, ACCEPTANCE AND SURRENDER OF PREMISES

The Applicant agrees to accept the County property on possession as being in a satisfactory state of repair and in sanitary condition.

The Applicant must surrender the premises to Lee County in the same condition as when Applicant takes possession, allowing for reasonable use and wear, and damage by acts of God. Applicant agrees to remove all business signs or symbols placed on the premises by the Applicant before redelivery of the premises to Lee County, and restore the premises to the condition in which it existed before their placement. Any signs and markings created or used in connection with this event must be temporary and removable; painting roadways, trees or any other fixed object is strictly prohibited. Applicant agrees to clear the Lee County property of litter at the close of the event.

SECTION V - AGREEMENT

The Applicant agrees that Lee County can, at its sole discretion, terminate and cancel its permit to use Lee County property at any time without prejudice. Applicant further agrees to waive, release, save and hold harmless Lee County from any and all claims, demands or cause of actions based upon Lee County's cancellation or termination of said permit.

The Applicant agrees that the Lee County permit does not provide Applicant with any property rights in the County property in question or in the permit itself.

The applicant does acknowledge and hereby affirms that any and all information is accurate to the best of his/her knowledge.

The FMB Lions want to hold our annual Shrimp Festival at Lynn Hall Park the weekend of March 9 & 10, 2019.

We have already entered into a contract with the County Parks & Recreation Department for the use of Lynn Hall Park for the weekend of March 9 & 10, 2019.

Permit applications have also been sent the State of Florida for the closing of the Matanzas Bridge for the 5K Race to be held from 9AM until 10AM and the Parade to be held from 10AM until 12PM on Saturday the 9th; and the Town of Ft. Myers Beach for the entire weekend.

The annual Kid's Shrimp run will be held on Ft. Myers Beach, on the beach, from Gulf Beach Rd. to Connecticut St. on Saturday, March 2nd. Registration is from 8AM – 9AM, the race starts at 9AM. This is the same venue and timing that was used for more than 15 years and started again last year. It is being sponsored by the Cypress Lake High School Boosters. Liam Farrell, Cypress Lake High School Athletic Director, is the contact person, 239-481-2233. They will carry the necessary insurance as will the Lions also include the event for coverage.

The Arts and Craft Expo is to be held at Lynn Hall Park, 950 Estero Blvd., Ft. Myers Beach, from 9am-6pm on Saturday the 9th and 9am-5pm on Sunday the 10th.

The 5 K race sponsored by Cypress Lake Athletics is to be held on Saturday the 9th from 9AM until 10AM. The race route is from Doc Fords on Fisherman Wharf, under bridge to San Carlos, over bridge to Estero Blvd. to the Key Estero Plaza, turn around and head North on Estero Blvd. to 5th St, 5th St to Crescent St., Crescent to 1st St(under bridge), 1st to Old San Carlos, Old San Carlos to Estero Blvd (over the bridge ,(road turns into San Carlos Blvd), San Carlos Blvd. to Main St, Main to Fisherman's Wharf, race ends at Doc Fords. Liam Farrell, Cypress Lake Athletic Director, is the race chair, 239-481-2233. They, along with the Lions, will carry the necessary liability insurance.

The Shrimp Parade is to be held on Saturday the 9th, from 10am until noon. The parade route runs from Bay Rd & Estero Blvd. to where Estero Blvd. runs into Old San Carlos Blvd.

The Queens contest is held at Lynn Hall Park on Saturday the 9th after the Shrimp Parade. Approximately from 1pm - 3pm.

The Shrimp Eating contest will be held at Lynn Hall Park; Sunday, March 10th at 1PM.

The required insurance is being covered by Lions Club International, with the appropriate departments and government agencies: Lee County BOCC: Risk Management, Town of Ft. Myers Beach, and the Fl Dept. of Transportation listed.

Port-A-Ports will be located at the start of the parade on Saturday and 8 units will be at Lynn Hall Park for the entire weekend. They will be delivered Friday morning and removed on Sunday morning along the parade route and Monday morning at Lynn Hall Park.






Shrimp Festival Detour Map for Parade & 5K run March 9th, 9am to 12pm, 2019
