SECTION I - SAFETY

The Applicant agrees to provide adequate traffic and crowd control, emergency medical services and any other items, at the Applicant's expense, required by Lee County to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. Lee County shall have the power to review the proposal and require, as necessary, detailed plans, diagrams, and explanations to clearly outline to Lee County, exactly what the Applicant is proposing.

SECTION II - INSURANCE

The Applicant, at its sole expense, agrees to procure and maintain in force during the entire term of the application, liability insurance in the amounts determined by Lee County Risk Management to protect against damages or other claims arising from use of County property by the applicant or its guests. Other limits may also be established by Lee County Risk Management for events which will be serving or consuming alcoholic beverages at approved County property. The insurance policy must also include coverage for Applicant's contingent liability on damages, claims or losses. "Lee County Board of County Commissioners" must be named as "additional insured" on the Certificate of Insurance, and the Certificate must be delivered to Lee County prior to Applicant's use of the property. The Insurance may not be canceled during the term of the event, if this occurs, the County has the right to revoke approvals related to use of the County property for the event, without recourse by the applicant.

SECTION III - INDEMNIFICATION

The Applicant agrees to indemnify, release and save harmless Lee County against any and all claims, costs, demands, damages, judgments or injuries of any nature arising from the conduct or management of, or from any work or thing whatsoever done in or about said Lee County property or any building or structure appurtenant thereto or equipment thereof during the term of this Permit, or arising during such term from any act of negligence of the Applicant, Applicant's agents, contractors, or employees, or arising from any accident, injury, or damage whatsoever, however caused, to any person or persons, or to any property of any person, persons, corporation or corporations, occurring during the term of this agreement on, in, or about said Lee County property, and from and against all costs, attorney's fees, expenses and liabilities occurring in connection with any such claim or any action or proceeding brought thereon.

For film permit applicants: The permittee shall have on-site a responsible representative empowered with authority over the filming director, filming crews, participants and filming operation. Permittee shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the county, its officers, agents and employees from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, liabilities, expenditures or causes of action of any kind arising out of or occurring during the activities of the permittee, and resulting or occurring from any negligent act, omission or error of permittee, resulting in or relating to injuries to body, life, limb or property sustained in, about or upon the permitted premises or improvement thereto, or arising from the use of the premises.

SECTION IV - DELIVERY, ACCEPTANCE AND SURRENDER OF PREMISES

The Applicant agrees to accept the County property on possession as being in a satisfactory state of repair and in sanitary condition.

The Applicant must surrender the premises to Lee County in the same condition as when Applicant takes possession, allowing for reasonable use and wear, and damage by acts of God. Applicant agrees to remove all business signs or symbols placed on the premises by the Applicant before redelivery of the premises to Lee County, and restore the premises to the condition in which it existed before their placement. Any signs and markings created or used in connection with this event must be temporary and removable; painting roadways, trees or any other fixed object is strictly prohibited. Applicant agrees to clear the Lee County property of litter at the close of the event.



SECTION V - AGREEMENT





This project has been reviewed to determine compliance with the Florida Fire Prevention Code, as required Florida Statues 553.79(2). This fire review is limited to the documents provided and available from the applicant prior to a ePlan file being created within the Lee County database for a fire review.

- 1. Preparation area for the fireworks show/display shall isolate/secure all members of the public from a minimum of at least 100 feet from any fireworks materials. NFPA 1123
- 2. Inspection required from fire district fire inspector of event concessions and spectator area prior to event beginning.
- 3. Must maintain access in and around the event in the event of emergency.
- Provide crowd control managers at a ratio of 1 person for every 250 persons at the event. With approval and cooperation from LCSO, may count LCSO toward the staffing requirement.
- 5. No tents, concessions, spectators, food trucks, and/or buildings permitted within a radius of 105 feet from any fireworks device. This are is referred to the fallout area. Fall out area shall not lapse into any uncontrolled areas, such as adjoining parcels.
- 6. All food trucks and temporary food cooking shall be compliant with NFPA 1-50. Maintain a separation distance of at least 10 feet from tents and concessions from the food trucks.

- Fireworks Show to commence at 9:00 PM for a 20 minute show
 - Shoot Site blockade is highlighted in Orange and designated on Site Plans
 - We will staff the isolation barricade with 2 team members to ensure that only fireworks launch team is in the shoot site isolation area.
 - o The main spectating area will be the grassy area in the middle of the site plan (Dotted oval in middle of site plans #1, 3, 4, 5, 6)
 - There is an additional spectating area which might be used by people parking their cars and watching the fireworks display show in the 2 acres (Top dotted area on Site Map #4)
 - During Fireworks display show volunteers and staff will maintain their positions and responsibilities. The goal of the staff and team is to ensure a safe and fun experience for the community of Lehigh Acres to enjoy the 4th of July celebration and fireworks



Safety Measures

 - There are 18 Team members that will float and assist, crowd guidance or help the designated team member spots


