Lee County is seeking additional Contractor Licensing Board (CLB) members. The current CLB is in need of:

- 1. One Air Conditioning or Mechanical Contractor,
- 2. One Architect or Engineer, and
- 3. One Consumer Representative.

Lee County Ordinance 00-26 establishes the need for a local Contractor Licensing Board. The main purpose of this Board is to review applications and grant or deny Lee County Certificates of Competency to applicants seeking to become licensed contractors in unincorporated Lee County.

Each member (except the Consumer Representatives) must:

- 1. Hold a state or local certificate to contract, an
- 2. Be actively engaged in the construction business, and
- 3. Have five consecutive years of contracting experience prior to appointment, and
- 4. Be a resident of Lee County and at least eighteen years of age.

Each Consumer Representative must:

- 1. Be a resident of Lee County, and
- 2. Be at least eighteen years of age, and
- 3. Not be, either currently or in the past, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the Board or a member of any closely related profession.
