- Notice is hereby given that HACFM/LCHA intends to submit a regional Assessment of Fair Housing in collaboration with the City of Fort Myers, City of Cape Coral, the Lee County Housing Authority, and Lee County. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires grantees to complete the Assessment of Fair Housing (AFH) in order to continue receiving federal housing and community development funding. The AFH will utilize HUD provided data and maps, in coordination with local information, data, and maps, to examine fair housing issues in Lee County.

HACFM/LCHA, in compliance with HUD regulation and local administrative code, encourages citizens to participate in the development of this assessment. HACFM/LCHA will hold a public hearing on April 26, 2017, at 5:00 PM at the Carrie Robinson Center, 2990 Edison Avenue, Fort Myers. All comments from citizens will be considered in preparing the final plan and reported in the document.
