Lee County Department of Transportation makes it a practice to hold public meetings on all new roadway alignments and major improvements. These public meetings are held to inform and solicit input from the public regarding the specific project being presented. The Summerlin Road public workshop was held to solicit public input regarding the 30% design plans for the widening from Boy Scout Drive to Cypress Lake Drive.

A public information workshop for the Summerlin Road Widening Project was held on August 20, 2002 at the Cypress Lake Middle School cafeteria in Fort Myers. The limits of the project are from Boy Scout Drive to Cypress Lake Drive. The purpose of the workshop was to present project information to the public and to gather public opinion. A total of 90 people signed in at the registration table. Copies of the sign-in-sheets are attached as Appendix A.

The public workshop was advertised in the August 13, 2002 edition of the News-Press as a ¼ page display ad. Letters announcing the public workshop were mailed on July 30, 2002 to persons with property lying within 300' of the right-of-way. The Lee County Department of Public Resources transmitted a press release to local media on May 16, 2002. As a result of the press release two articles were generated in the News-Press. Two variable message boards were placed within the project limits for a period of one week prior to the workshop to inform the traveling public. Copies of the notification for the workshop and newspaper articles are attached as Appendix B.

The meeting was conducted in an open-format style that allowed the public to view the project material between the hours of 4:30 to 6:30 pm. Information regarding a noise study that was conducted in several areas around Lee County including the Summerlin Road corridor was available for review. Copies of the noise evaluation report were available for the public to purchase for a reproduction fee of \$53.32 per report. A copy of the request to purchase the report is in Appendix C. A project hand-out, that summarized the project to date, was provided to the public at the registration table. In addition, a brochure about the Lee County MPO and their planning process was available. Representatives from the Lee County Department of Transportation were stationed at the display boards to explain the project data and answer the public's questions. Copies of the public workshop hand-out and MPO brochure are attached as Appendix C.

The public was provided with comment forms in order to have their opinion recorded as public record. A total of 41 comment forms were received from the meeting and during the two-week comment period following the meeting. The comments were analyzed and recorded below. The response indicates if/how the project team is addressing the public comment. The numbers in parenthesis indicated the number of times the same or similar comment was submitted. Copies of the comment forms are attached as Appendix D.

In addition to the comment forms, the project team summarized the conversations held with persons attending the public workshop. In general the comments included discussions regarding the lack of a signal at the medial plaza/apartment complex, installation of a signal at Maple, noise walls and access management. The oral comment summary by the project team is attached as Appendix E.

WRITTEN COMMENTS

1. **Comment:** Need noise barrier – noise level will go up – should be at least 5’ or 8’ or 10’. (11)
Response: Lee County does not build noise barriers in county projects. A copy of our analysis for this project is available for \$53.00.
2. **Comment:** Want landscaping in medians, right-of-way & around detention ponds. (10)
Response: Core level landscaping (canopy trees and palms, flowering trees and bushes and sod) is included where possible on all improvements to existing facilities and new facilities in the medians and in some cases in both the ROW & medians. Core level landscaping does not include the area around dry retention areas.
3. **Comment:** There is nowhere to cross Summerlin Road for bicyclists or pedestrians. Even if crosswalks are constructed crossing a six-lane facility is very dangerous. Especially need a crossing at Antiqua Bay & Horizon for school children. (9)
Response: There are currently crosswalks along Summerlin Road at Cypress Lake Drive, ECC, College Parkway, and Park Meadows Drive. The new design will keep all of these crossings. Based upon public comments the county will be adding sidewalk to the east side of the road. The county is also relocating the proposed signal at the commercial property (just south of Boy Scout Drive) to Horizon Boulevard. The combination of additional sidewalk and a signal at this intersection allow for crosswalks.
4. **Comment:** Install a traffic light at the intersection of Antiqua Bay, Summerlin Medical Center & the Horizon Apartments instead of the proposed location further to the north just south of Boy Scout Drive. (7)
Response: The county is relocating the proposed signal to this intersection.
5. **Comment:** Reduce size of retention pond #12 so that existing landscaping can remain. (5)
Response: The design team is evaluating the possibility of reducing the size of this retention area.
6. **Comment:** Concerned about the merge to Whiskey Creek Drive with only one lane for left turns onto westbound College from Summerlin & the continuous right from Summerlin to westbound College – seems it will create a dangerous situation. (4)
Response: The current design will still provide dual left turn lanes from northbound Summerlin Rd. to westbound College Pkwy. Because of the free flow right turn movement from southbound Summerlin Rd. to College Pkwy. the right hand turn into Corporate Court has been closed. This will provide extended distance for lane changes before reaching Whiskey Creek/College Pkwy intersection.
7. **Comment:** Concerned about property values decreasing due to noise levels. (4)
Response: No detrimental effects to market values have been recorded on the majority of Lee County DOT completed projects. In several instances property values have increased after project completion.
8. **Comment:** Waste of tax money or tremendous waste of financial resources. (3)

Response: In 2001, Summerlin Road from Boy Scout Drive to Cypress Lake Drive was categorized as Level of Service (LOS D). This does not meet county standards. The traffic data also predicts a 38% increase in volumes by the year 2020 for the section of roadway between Boy Scout Drive and College Parkway. The current LOS combined with the future traffic projections establishes the need to increase the capacity for this section of roadway in order to meet the expected future traffic demands.

9. **Comment:** Nice Presentation or Good Idea to have this Open Forum. (3)
Response: No response necessary.
10. **Comment:** Widening of Summerlin Road will have a negative impact on Whiskey Creek Country Club Estates. (3)
Response: The new road will not be any closer to Whiskey Creek than the existing road is now. The curbing, sidewalk and existing walls will remain undisturbed.
11. **Comment:** Don't just widen existing roadways, consider adding roads between existing facilities (east-west routes). (3)
Response: This is not a viable option in an urban setting due to the dense development in the area. Right of way costs would be too high and would displace too many current residences and businesses.
12. **Comment:** Need to enclose all of the drainage (including detention ponds) to prevent disease. (2)
Response: These areas are "dry detention" areas and are designed not to hold water most of the time. Dry detention areas are a widely excepted practice around Florida and the rest of the United States.
13. **Comment:** Maintain and enforce 45 mph speed limit (2)
Response: The speed limit will be established according to the engineering criteria. Enforcement for the speed limit is the jurisdiction of the appropriate law enforcement agency.
14. **Comment:** Problem is south of College Pkwy. The overpass to keep traffic moving doesn't make sense when you have traffic lights every few blocks anyway you have to stop for. (1)
Response: In order to achieve adequate Levels of Service for the projected volumes, the intersection requires an overpass.
15. **Comment:** New road should be constructed further east of the existing wall at Whiskey Creek to reduce noise and other negative impacts. (1)
Response: Moving the alignment further east would be cost prohibitive and impact large numbers of FPL structures.
16. **Comment:** Keep southbound right turn lane onto Presidential Court in design. (1)
Response: The slip ramp from southbound Summerlin Rd. to westbound Corporate Ct. has been eliminated from the design plans due to cost and private property impact.
17. **Comment:** Consider feasibility of noise walls made of other materials than currently used to reduce cost of noise barriers – find a compromise that both DOT and residents can live with. (1)
Response: Lee County does not build noise barriers in county projects. However, we are open to specific suggestions.
18. **Comment:** Would have been helpful to have small handouts of the plan. (1)

Response: Reduced scale plans are available upon request. Requests can be submitted to Cella & Associates, Inc.

19. **Comment:** Southbound directional left at Albertson as proposed will create accidents, eliminate it. (1)
Response: The southbound directional left at Albertson's has an ample length for both the deceleration and storage of cars turning left. This access will reduce the number of vehicles utilizing the signal at Cypress Lake and should reduce crashes.
20. **Comment:** Turn lanes onto College from Summerlin need to be longer. (1)
Response: All turning movements and related lanes have been extended as recommended by the Traffic Study Report performed by Metro Transportation. A design report was completed that analyzed the projected turning volumes. The turn lanes were designed to accommodate the future turning traffic. A copy of this report is available for your review by contacting Project Manager, Don DeBerry.
21. **Comment:** Lengthen right turn lane into Edison Community College or add a second right turn lane. (1)
Response: A design report was completed that analyzed the projected turning volumes. The turn lanes were designed to accommodate the future turning traffic. A copy of this report is available.
22. **Comment:** Improve drainage at area north of Boy Scout & Summerlin intersection. (1)
Response: A portion of this intersection will have to be redesigned as part of this project. All drainage within the limits of the intersection will be addressed and modified accordingly. Areas further north of the intersection itself will not be included within this project.
23. **Comment:** With six lanes and all that traffic who is going to want to use bike path along Summerlin? (1)
Response: There has been interest by the Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee with regard to bicycle facilities on this project. It is an individual's preference as to whether or not to ride a bike along this facility.
24. **Comment:** Summerlin & College needs a cloverleaf system. (1)
Response: Due to cost and space restrictions, the cloverleaf concept was not considered as a viable option for this intersection.
25. **Comment:** The "slip" ramp off Summerlin should be widened so it could be utilized as a two-way right-of-way. (1)
Response: The slip ramp from southbound Summerlin Rd. to westbound Corporate Ct. has been eliminated from the design plans due to cost and private property impact.
26. **Comment:** Install Green Belt Hedge as a noise barrier. (1)
Response: Vegetation has proved to be ineffective as a noise barrier. Its effects are largely psychological. Lee County does not build noise barriers in county projects.
27. **Comment:** With Brantley losing left turn - make the U-Turn under the over pass as simple a design as possible so it is user friendly. (1)
Response: Current design allows for u-turn movements under the overpass. The same design concept is being utilized at US 41 and Colonial Blvd. as well as McGregor Blvd, and McGregor and College Pkwy. The design criteria being used will allow for cars and trucks to make the u-turn movement easily.

28. **Comment:** Re-address flooding of retention area between University Grill and Albertson. Currently over flows into Albertsons parking lot. (1)
Response: This is a private property design characteristic and not part of this county project.
29. **Comment:** Slight modifications may come to the attention of the design engineers from public input, but basically the project will be a done deal. (1)
Response: Public meetings for the county roadway projects are held specifically to inform the public of the project and to solicit public comment. Public comments are addressed and where possible modifications to the design are made. The number of comments made with regard to any element of the project along with engineering criteria and cost feasibility help determine which modifications may be made.
30. **Comment:** Ban commercial trucks from using Summerlin. (1)
Response: Can't do that, as it would defeat the purpose of an arterial road.
31. **Comment:** Install traffic signal at Summerlin & Maple Drive. (1)
Response: The signal is being designed.
32. **Comment:** How will the existing wall between Whiskey Creek & Summerlin Rd. be protected from damage during construction of the proposed improvements? (1)
Response: Since the existing curb line along Whiskey Creek will remain in-place; there should be no construction equipment behind the curb. In the event that there is any damage to the wall from construction activities, the contractor will be responsible for making any repairs and/or replacing the damaged wall.

INTRODUCTION

The Lee County Department of Transportation (DOT) welcomes you to this public information workshop for the Summerlin Road Widening Project. Representatives from Lee County DOT are present this evening to discuss project information and answer your questions. **There will not be a formal presentation this evening.** Design plans and project information are positioned around the room in separate stations. Each station contains the same project information; feel free to visit any of the four (4) stations. Comment forms are provided in this handout and can be deposited in the comment boxes this evening or can be mailed to the address provided on the back of the form within 14 days. All comments will become part of the project record.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The limits of the project are from Boy Scout Drive to Cypress Lake Drive. The project consists of the engineering necessary to widen the current four-lane corridor to six lanes within the project limits. The project also includes an urban interchange design for the intersection of College Parkway and Summerlin Road. An urban interchange consists of a ramp constructed over an intersection so that through traffic continues without interruption from traffic signals.

PURPOSE AND NEED

The transportation planning process takes into account the needs for Lee County over a twenty-year horizon. This ongoing process identifies what types of improvements will be needed by the planning horizon year. The Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) consists of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Lee County and all incorporated cities within the county. These government entities work together in an attempt to identify and meet the transportation needs for the county as a whole. During the planning process, the MPO advertises meetings regarding transportation planning in the local media and provides full public access to decisions and documents. It supports early and continuing public involvement in the development and review of its transportation plans and programs. Once decisions are made they are adopted into the MPO 2020 Financially Feasible Highway Plan which outlines the County's future transportation needs and establishes if funding is available by which those needs can be accomplished. **The widening of Summerlin Road from Boy Scout Drive to Cypress Lake Drive was incorporated into the MPO 2020 Plan in 1990 and is identified as a six-lane divided roadway.**

Many factors are used during the planning process. One of the factors, Level of Service (LOS), is a grading system used by traffic engineers as a tool to assess how roadways are functioning in terms of traffic flow. This grading system uses letters from A-F to assign degrees of function from best to worst. When a roadway is graded as LOS F the roadway can be categorized as extremely congested and traffic flow is drastically impeded. In 2001, Summerlin Road from Boy Scout Drive to Cypress Lake Drive was categorized as LOS D (Lee County DOT, Traffic Division). The traffic data also predicts a 38% increase in volumes by the year 2020 for the section of roadway between Boy Scout Drive and College Parkway. The current LOS combined with the future traffic projections establishes the need to increase the capacity for this section of roadway in order to meet the expected future traffic demands. Graphics depicting LOS from A-F are on display this evening.

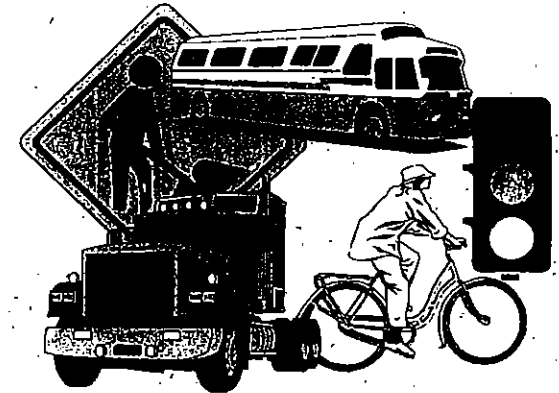

To Whom It May Concern:

After attending a meeting regarding the Summerlin Road Widening Project, we have some concerns.

The current plan is to place a stoplight at the entrance just south of Boy Scout at the entrance of a planned commercial development on the corner of Summerlin and Boy Scout.

A short distance south of this light is an intersection which has Horizons (a housing community) on one side and Antigua Bay (another housing community) along with a Summerlin Medical Park on the other side. There is also an area of future expansion zoned for multiple dwellings. Summerlin Medical Park also has room to expand.

The plans for this intersection are to remove the ability of turning left out of either of these areas.

It is obvious that there is substantially more traffic at the present time out of this other intersection to warrant a light at this location opposed to the planned location. We were informed that there were "studies" done that did not warrant a light at this area. However, we believe that these studies did not take the entire picture into account.


Currently, there have been several accidents at this intersection. The current and planned road has somewhat of a BLIND curve to the south of this intersection. Although there is a sign "reduced speed ahead" and the speed limit is 35 MPH at the intersection, the traffic definitely is traveling faster than this. Increasing the lanes to 3 will only encourage speeds to increase. I would consider this an UNSAFE design. Drivers who want to go south entering Summerlin must travel north to the U-turn not too far ahead. Drivers would tend to cross all lanes while not being able to see the oncoming traffic due to the blind curve.

The solution would be to place a light at this intersection which would be timed to coordinate with the light at Boy Scout. This would be much safer, still allow for easy egress on and off Summerlin from the new development due to the lights at both intersections and there is no blind curve near this intersection.

I would like a copy of this study to examine to determine if this blind curve and tendency to exceed the speed limits around this blind curve have been taken into account. If it has not, I feel that the county would be approving an UNSAFE design and could lead to liability problems if another serious accident occurs at this intersection.

Thank you for considering this point of view and my request for a copy of the study regarding the traffic lights in this area.

Dear Summerlin Road Project Consultants:

I am very disappointed at the design of the segment of Summerlin Road from Boy Scout to Cypress Lake, especially as it pertains to pedestrian and bicycle elements, or, more accurately, lack thereof. Even taking into account that the current design uses all of the available right-of-way, this kind of omission should not even be considered.

In fact, failing to include adequate facilities along the east side of Summerlin from Boy Scout to Maple and from College to Cypress Lake, as was presented at the August 20th workshop, puts Lee County out of compliance with its own Bikeway/Walkways Facilities Plan. The development that already exists along those segments, as well as along other points on the east side of Summerlin, was allowed to occur without including bike/ped facilities due to an interpretation of the Facilities Plan that permitted developers to consider the existing bikepath on the west side to constitute compliance with the Plan. Since the time that many of those unfortunate oversights were allowed the Bikeways/Walkways Facilities Plan has been updated to clearly indicate facilities along both sides. Now, it appears, the same body that adopted that version of the plan is giving itself a waiver that a developer wouldn't - nor shouldn't - be granted.

Further complicating things is that the sheer width of the roadway, especially at intersections, will make it very difficult and dangerous for non-motorists to traverse, even where pedestrian signals and crosswalks are provided. People are being put at risk unnecessarily whenever they must cross Summerlin twice in order to travel on a paved bike/ped pathway merely because there is no facility on one side.

Even more disturbing is that what is proposed is not unlike many similar roadways that exist in Miami-Dade and other sprawling communities. Roadways that sacrifice overall safety and access for the perceived benefit of keeping motor vehicle traffic flowing at high speeds, only to be frequently stopped at signalized intersections or to be caught in even more intense congestion. Roadways that divide neighborhoods by creating multi-lane barriers that are all but impassable to anyone outside of their automobile (and even then is a challenge). Roadways that do nothing to enhance the environment for those who live nearby. Roadways that are deathtraps for any non-motorists who use them, especially when attempting to get across their daunting width.

There are better ways to move people than by running major highways through the middle of town. If we continue in this manner Fort Myers will surely turn into the kind of east coast clone we are trying to avoid becoming.

I would like to make these comments after attending your public presentation Wednesday evening, August 20, 2002, at the Cypress Lake Middle School concerning the widening and improvements? on Summerlin Road from Boy Scout Drive To Cypress Lake Drive.

Our practice is located in Summerlin Medical Park, which is on the northeast corner of the intersection created by the Horizons Apartments, Antigua Bay Apartments and our office with Summerlin Road approximately one-quarter of a mile south of the Boy Scout intersection. We have been in this location for 16 years. As the apartments were developed, it became apparent that this intersection needed some sort of traffic control. We have requested studies for a traffic light in the past.

There are approximately 240 residential units in the Antigua Bay development and approximately 175 units in the Horizons development across Summerlin. There is also 10 acres of multifamily zoned land to the south and east of Summerlin Medical Park. The intersection to which I refer is quite busy. Even of more significance is the amount of pedestrian traffic that crosses Summerlin at that point. There is a Lee Tran bus stop on the east side of Summerlin, and people from Horizons Apartments are constantly coming across Summerlin for that bus stop. There are also school buses that go into both the Horizons entrance and the Antigua Bay entrance. There are children crossing this street all the time. The Horizons is a rent supported project and has many large families and many children in those units. Antigua Bay is a market rate apartment complex, but attracts a large blue collar following, and there are many residents in that area. Our practice along with the practices of Drs. James and Yolanda Mitchell and Marie Gale are quite active and we have hundreds of patients a day that are using this intersection.



The quality of life in this area will decrease because noise levels will increase significantly. Sound barriers, solid or natural, should be considered for this section of the project.

Additionally, we oppose the planned size of Detention Pond #12. (Refer to Proposed Replat of Undivided Block E and Part of Undivided Block 1-J of Whiskey Creek Country Estates Unit A.) Due to the size it will require removal of numerous trees and bushes that currently act as a sound barrier. The size of Detention Pond #12 could be decreased and compensated for by increasing the size of proposed Detention Pond #11. Ideally in a 50/50 ratio. Additionally, request that the area between Pond #12 and the fence be landscaped with low maintenance plantings.

Summary of Conversations with Public:

- 1) It was reported to us that the right-turn lane into Albertson's currently has a tendency to flood as the ditches along the east side of the road fill up. This also happens to be the location in our proposed drainage system that has the highest proposed proposed hydraulic grade line elevation and the lowest curb elevation. ABB will further investigate the drainage in this area.
- 2) One of the commercial property owners in University Center stated that he would recommend that the Tenants Association consider selling the land along University Drive for the proposed detention area.
- 3) Concern was expressed by several attendees that the northbound dual-lefts onto College Parkway are going to be reduced to a single lane, when traffic currently backs up at this location.
- 4) Reduced access to the Hilton is a major problem, especially since we need to acquire right-of-way from them.
- 5) Concern of detention pond #12 located on the west side of the road on existing county land will destroy the tree buffer for residents of Whiskey Creek. The pond can be designed in such a manner as to leave most of the trees in-place.
- 6) The possibility of not having a signal at Maple Drive concerned a lot of residents. They complained about the accidents that occur there now as a result of people trying to turn-left out of Maple while avoiding cars speeding around the curve.
- 7) Residents were upset that no signal was planned for the Horizon's intersection but that there was a signal planned for the new Sander's property. They also expressed concern that the traffic from the Boy Scout Drive intersection would be backed up due to the close proximity of the signal.
- 8) An employee of Lee County Health Services was concerned with the pedestrian movements at Maple Drive. He assists many residents in that area that cross Summerlin Road to access the shopping center located in the vicinity of Whiskey Creek.
