Quorum was confirmed with 9 members present.

Winston Church called the regular monthly meeting of the Roadway Landscape Advisory Committee (RLAC) to order at 6:00 pm.

Approval of the February 2, 2016 Regular Meeting Minutes:

Winston Church asked for a motion to approve the February 2, 2015 RLAC meeting minutes, <u>a</u> motion was made by Jennifer Evans to approve the minutes, seconded by Clark Ryals; the motion was called and carried.

NEW BUSINESS

60% Plans, Summerlin Rd. from Boy Scout Dr. to Colonial Blvd.

Bob DeBrock stated that the City of Ft. Myers had concerns with the maintenance and appearance of this portion of Summerlin so it was decided to make some improvements by installing a core level of landscape. This is the last segment of Summerlin that needed landscaped to complete Summerlin to Sanibel.

Jonathan Romine of Ensite presented the 60% conceptual landscape design plans for Summerlin Rd. from Boy Scout Dr. to Colonial Blvd. The plans include some tree removal and a core level plan with no irrigation. When inspecting the existing landscape they found that some of the trees have safety concerns. There are 28 trees needing removed some as a result of accidents, there are Oaks that are planted too close together, some have not been properly pruned and some are dead. After removing these trees there will be 79 new trees added consisting of Hong Kong Orchids, Cathedral Live Oaks, Royal and Sabal Palms. Rustic pine bark nuggets will be used and Bahia sod. The design intent is to soldier the Royals at each end and fill in with Oaks and Sabals, keeping the clear zone and site line issues at the intersections. The constraints dealt with are narrow medians and clear zone requirements.

Debbie Hughes questioned the choice of using Hong Kong Orchids. Jonathan stated that he is keeping consistent with the rest of the roadway. James McCord added that they do well in medians. John Sibley inquired on understory planting. Jonathan stated there are a few understory plantings along Summerlin but to stay within the core level specifications he has not added any in this design. Debbie asked the size of the Oaks being removed. Jonathan said the largest are 24" caliber. Bob mentioned that due to them planted so close together the trees have been stunted. Jonathan stated that they are saving all trees that can be saved. Removing the bad trees will allow others to thrive.

JB stated there was a concern of the height of the Royals by the Cities Beautification Advisory Committee, they are asking for 10 foot gray wood instead of the designed 6 foot. The RLAC members all agree with the smaller ones. He also suggested peanut grass instead of Bahia.

Stephen Brown suggested using an enhanced fertilizer for the Hong Kong Orchids due to potassium deficiencies

Greg Diserio made a motion to accept the 60% Conceptual Landscape Plans for Summerlin Rd. from Boy Scout Dr. to Colonial Blvd., seconded by James McCord, motion was called and carried.

16/17 Prioritization List

Bob DeBrock spoke to the committee on the prioritization list asking them to give him a list of roadways that they would like to have prioritized. All suggestions can be sent to Bob though email. There is no funds available presently but we should be working on the list and also focus on the maintenance issues we currently are experiencing.

Delprado Blvd. from Hancock Bridge Pkwy. to Pine Island Rd.

Bob DeBrock stated there is a CIP project for 16/17 for Delprado from Hancock Bridge Pkwy. to Pine Island Rd. The 100% plans that were approved by the RLAC are not feasible so this will be redesigned to meet core level with no irrigation. Original plans state that we would be moving some of the Sabals however the medians are high and the Sabals have problems so the Sabals will be pulled out. Bob would like to have another meeting in May to present the 60% plans for Delprado. The committee agreed to meet on May 3rd.
