Roadwatch Update
July 22 – July 28, 2021

Plantation Road and Lancer Avenue, Fort Myers (ROW2020-00913): Bonness, Inc. will be performing roadway improvements beginning Monday, July 26 and continuing to August 31, 2021. Asphalt pavement and concrete curbing improvements will be performed. There will be a flagman operation due to a lane closure on Plantation Road, in front of the jobsite, to add a turn lane. Periodic lane closures for northbound and southbound lanes will occur between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on weekdays. For further information, please contact Jeff Krull at (239) 450-8319. Acme Barricades will provide maintenance of traffic services.

College Parkway (8211), Fort Myers (ROW2021-00278): Hallmark Paving Inc. will be constructing a deceleration lane and performing roadway and sidewalk improvements on College Parkway. Hancock Bridge Parkway Improvements (NE 16th Place to SE 24th Avenue), Cape Coral: Lee County DOT, along with their contractor Andrew Site Work, are working on improvements along Hancock Bridge Parkway. This project includes roadway construction, drainage, utilities, and signing and pavement markings. **The outside westbound lane of Hancock Bridge Parkway, from NE 20th Court to Kurt Donaldson Community Park, will be closed for the weekend starting at 6 p.m. on Friday, July 30, and will reopen at 6 a.m. on Monday, August 2, 2021. 1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvements:

Alico Road, from Jean Street to US 41, Fort Myers (ROW2020-00412): Pike Electric will be replacing utility poles **beginning Wednesday, June 23, 2021, and continuing through Friday, July 30, 2021.** Work will include pulling out old utility poles and replacing them with new poles, wires and transformers. Motorists are urged to use caution in the work area. There will be periodic lane closures in the westbound and eastbound lanes of Alico Road between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. on weekdays. Area Wide Protective of Fort Myers will provide maintenance of traffic services. Burnt Store Road from Tropicana Parkway to Pine Island Road: Construction Project: This project consists of widening Burnt Store Road to four lanes. The project also includes construction of a new bridge over Shadroe Canal, drainage installation, and lighting. Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures during nighttime/overnight hours, weather permitting. Motorists should use caution while driving in the area. This south segment from Tropicana Parkway to Pine Island Road costs \$13.6 million. The contractor is Wright Construction. The project is expected to be **completed by late fall 2023**. Caloosa Road and Oriole Road, Fort Myers (ROW2021-00016): Irby Construction will be replacing poles on Caloosa Road, between Phlox Drive and Oriole Road, and on Oriole Road, between San Carlos Boulevard and Pennsylvania Boulevard, for Florida Power & Light (FPL) beginning Monday, April 19, and **continuing through July 30, 2021**. The westbound lane of Caloosa Road and northbound lane of Oriole Road will be subject to periodic lane closures between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. weekdays. Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase I Construction Project: The project widens Corkscrew Road to six lanes from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Fire House Lane, and to four lanes from Fire House Lane to Bella Terra Boulevard. The project includes adding on-road bike lanes, some sidewalk, and new drainage. A wildlife crossing will be constructed approximately 1000 feet west of the entrance to Cypress Shadows Boulevard, which coincides with a regional flow-way that crosses Corkscrew Road at that location. Once the project is completed, the Village of Estero will be installing shared use paths, lighting, and landscaping. **Currently crews are working in the median between Ben Hill Griffin Parkway and Wildcat Run. Traffic is shifted through the Ben Hill Griffin intersection, and to the outside of Corkscrew Road. Motorists should expect miscellaneous turn lane closures and bike lane detours throughout the project. Drivers are urged to use caution and be aware of a new traffic pattern.** The following work activities are scheduled to occur, weather permitting:

- **Underground work continues in the entrance/exit to Wild Blue on Wild Blue Boulevard through the first week of August.** Crews are currently working in the west

driveway (exit) of Wild Blue Boulevard, with two-way traffic utilizing the east driveway (entrance). Once work is completed on the west side of Wild Blue Boulevard, crews will move and work in the east driveway (entrance) on Wild Blue Boulevard, with two-way traffic utilizing the west driveway (exit) out of the development.

- **During the daytime hours 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., motorists should expect a flagging operation for westbound traffic from Stoneybrook Golf Drive to Ben Hill Griffin Parkway for crews to complete curb work. This work will also require the bike lane to be closed.** Bicyclists must share the travel lane in this area.
- **During the daytime hours from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, July 23, motorists should expect traffic to shift just east of the entrance to the Shoppes at Grande Oak. The right-turn lane into the shopping center will be closed, but right turns into the plaza are permitted from the westbound, through lane.**

Crews are installing curb and drainage, performing earthwork, and relocating utilities. Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion is fall 2023.** Project cost is approximately \$23 M. The contractor is Cougar Contracting, LLC. Estero Boulevard Construction – reFRESH Estero Boulevard/Waterlines – Strandview Avenue to the south end of the island.

Contractors for Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, and sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, sidewalk, and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Strandview Avenue to the south end of the Island. **Motorists may experience daytime and nighttime intermittent one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.** Motorists may experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work Monday through Friday and most Saturdays.
