**Roadwatch Update**  
**May 26, 2022 – June 1, 2022**

**1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement**

**Striping Maintenance:** Lee County DOT will be performing a moving operation with traffic delays on **5-26-22 through 6-1-22** between the hours of **9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**, weather permitting on the following roadways:

**Intersection Markings:** Intermittent lane closures and delays are possible on **5-26-22 through 6-1-22** between the hours of **9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**, weather permitting on the following roadways:

**Winkler Road, Fort Myers (ROW2020-00484):** Mastec Utility Services will be working for FPL installing new poles and transferring underground lines from old poles to new poles beginning on **Monday, November 29, 2021 and continuing through June 2022**. Work will take place from **9:00 AM to 3:00 PM** and some nighttime work may be included. There will be no lane closures; however, Mastec will be setting down mats to get bucket trucks to the poles. **Burnt Store Road from Tropicana Parkway to Pine Island Road:** Construction Project: This project consists of widening Burnt Store Road to four lanes. The project also includes construction of a new bridge over Shadroe Canal, drainage installation, and lighting. Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures during nighttime/overnight hours, weather permitting. Motorists should use caution while driving in the area. This south segment from Tropicana Parkway to Pine Island Road costs \$13.6 million. The contractor is Wright Construction. Crews will be conducting a 24-hour maintenance burn-in period for the lighting through the end of **April 2022**. Motorists should expect intermittent side road closures throughout the duration of the project as well as intermittent traffic shifts. The project is expected to be **completed by Fall 2022**. **Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase I Construction Project:** The project widens **Corkscrew Road to six lanes from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Fire House Lane, and to four lanes from Fire House Lane to Bella Terra Boulevard**. The project includes adding on-road bike lanes, some sidewalk, installing new drainage, and constructing a wildlife crossing approximately 1000 feet west of the entrance to Cypress Shadows Boulevard. This crossing will coincide with a regional flow-way that crosses Corkscrew Road at that location. Once the project is completed, the Village of Estero will be installing shared use paths, lighting, and landscaping. **Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone. Please be aware of shifts in travel lanes and bike lanes, sidewalk detours, miscellaneous turn lane closures, and uneven pavement throughout the project.** Corkscrew motorists should expect slower than usual traffic when approaching **Wild Blue** as work is occurring in the communities' entrances.

The following work activities are scheduled to occur, weather permitting.

Motorists using **Wild Blue Boulevard** should expect crews working underground in the entrance to Wild Blue. Currently crews have the inbound driveway closed and the exit is open to two-way travel. Once the contractor completes this work in the entrance, they will switch traffic to the entrance and move to work in the exit. Work in the Wild Blue entrance is anticipated to continue through **June 2022**.

- **Wednesday, June 1, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM**, motorists should expect the westbound to **northbound right-turn lane from Corkscrew Road to Ben Hill Griffin Parkway CLOSED** for crews to perform work on underground utilities.
- **Friday, June 3, 2022 between the nighttime hours of 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM**, motorists should expect a **FLAGGING OPERATION and Corkscrew Road** to be limited to one lane of travel from west of Wildcat Run to Wild Blue Boulevard. Crews will be working on underground utilities on the north side of the roadway.
- Crews continue **construction of the bridge/wildlife crossing between Wild Blue Boulevard and The Preserve at Corkscrew** that will allow animals to cross under Corkscrew Road, similar to the crossing just east of Alico Road. A 10-foot-high fence will be installed to funnel the wildlife to cross at this location. Currently crews are constructing box culverts near the bridge/crossing that convey water under the roadway. Motorists should be aware of vehicles entering/exiting the road in this area.
- Bicyclists should expect the bike lane from Stoneybrook Golf Drive to just east of Wildcat Run to be combined with the travel lane while crews work on the north side of the road.
- Crews continue work on the southern side of the Ben Hill Griffin Parkway/Corkscrew Road intersection. Please use caution as crews work near the roadway.
- Pedestrians must use the temporary walkway on the south side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Stoneybrook Golf Drive.
- Currently in the area between Wild Blue Boulevard and Cypress Shadows Boulevard (The Preserve at Corkscrew) vehicles are using temporary lanes on the north side of the road to allow crews to work on the south side of Corkscrew Road.
- Turn lanes are currently unavailable at Wild Blue Boulevard and Cypress Shadows Boulevard (The Preserve at Corkscrew).

Crews are installing curb, drainage, and sod, as well as performing earthwork, and relocating utilities. **MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT.** Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. **Estimated completion is late 2023.** Project cost is approximately \$23 M. **Del Prado Boulevard & SE 47th Terrace, Cape Coral:** Lee County DOT, along with their contractor American Infrastructure Services (AIS), will be installing a new traffic signal mast arm at Del Prado Boulevard and Southeast 47th Terrace. This project includes a new mast arm and removing two of the existing mast arms. Motorists and pedestrians are urged to use extra caution in this area. **reFRESH Estero Boulevard/Waterlines – Albatross Street to the south end of the Island:**

Contractors for Fort Myers Beach and Lee County are installing new water main, and sanitary sewer force main, storm drainage, sidewalk, and rebuilding roadway on Estero Boulevard from Albatross Street to the south end of the Island. Motorists may experience daytime and nighttime intermittent one-lane traffic on Estero Boulevard. Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays. Motorists may experience momentary delays while crews move materials for the construction activities. Crews are expected to work **Monday through Friday and most Saturdays.**

**Albatross Street to the south end of the island.** Motorists may experience daytime lane shifts on Estero Boulevard while crews complete punch list items. **Sanibel Causeway Island “B” Shoreline Stabilization Project:** Lee County’s contractor, Spectrum Contracting, Inc., is providing services to stabilize the shoreline on Island “B”. The project consists of clearing exotic vegetation along the shoreline, excavating some existing stone that will be reused, placement of new beach sand, and construction of “T-Groins”. Expect large vehicles entering and exiting the roadway. Drivers and pedestrians should use extra caution in this area. **Caloosa Site Development Dollar General Store #23109 (ROW2022-00072)** Caloosa Site Development, Inc. will be performing concrete sidewalk and other improvements beginning **Monday March 7, 2022 and continue through July 31, 2022.** The westbound lane of Palm Beach Boulevard (S.R. 80) at the corner of New York Drive will be affected. No lane closures are anticipated, although site work will be close to the outside travel lane. Motorist caution is advised when traveling through this area. **US 41/Cleveland Avenue from Winkler Avenue to SR 82/Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard:** Construction Project, crews will be installing and relocating utilities and constructing medians on US41/Cleveland Avenue from Winkler Ave to SR 82.

- **Expect Canal Street (both sides) closed at US 41/Cleveland Avenue.**
- **Expect Victoria Avenue closed on the east side of US 41/Cleveland Avenue.**

- **Motorists should expect side road closures from Winkler Avenue to Victoria Avenue throughout the duration of the project.**
- **Motorists should expect intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures and detours on US 41/Cleveland Avenue during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours Monday through Friday throughout the duration of the project.**

Additional work includes installing drainage structures, pedestrian signals, upgrading signals and lighting, and resurfacing existing highway. The project will be constructed in three segments. Each segment will have the majority of construction completed prior to moving to the next segment. Construction will begin on the first segment from Winkler Avenue to Carrell Road. Crews will work on the west side of the road initially and when that work is completed, they will shift to the east side of Cleveland Avenue/US 41. The expected project completion date is **Spring 2023**.

**North Lee County Wellfield Expansion Phase IIIA Project – Fort Myers (ROW2022-00030):**

**Nalle Grade Road between Slater Road to Nalle Road** - RPU is installing a Raw Water Main and Fiber Optics Conduit via directional drill from **February 28, 2022 through September 30, 2022**. Work will be conducted in daylight hours from **7:00 AM – 7:00 PM**. The Directional Drill will be performed along Nalle Grade Road from Slater Road heading East towards Nalle Road. Eastbound lane along Nalle Grade Road from Slater Road to Nalle Road will be subject to **temporary daily lane closures or permanent lane closures**. Traffic will be maintained with either temporary traffic signals or flagmen depending on which MOT is used.

**Slater Road from Nalle Grade Road to Rich Road** - RPU has completed the open cut and HDD installation work. RPU will begin with the restoration of the swales and driveway repair that will begin on **June 6, 2022 through June 17, 2022**. Work will be conducted in daylight hours from **8:00 AM - 6:00 PM**. Work will be in the swale but lanes will be closed sporadically throughout the day. RPU will be using flagmen throughout the day to direct traffic when the travel lane is closed to perform the work. Lanes will be opened up daily.

**Orange Grove Blvd** - Lee County Department of Transportation will be conducting a sidewalk repair project starting on **March 11, 2022 and will continue through June 9, 2022**. The projected start date is **Tuesday, April 12, 2022 and will continue through Saturday, June 25, 2022.** The said sections of road will be subject to a lane closure with flaggers between **9:00 AM and 4:30 PM**, and Area Wide Protective will be providing MOT services. **Sanibel Causeway Bridge Structure:** Starting **April 18, 2022 and ending on November 24, 2022** from **9 AM to 4 PM**, Lee County will be making repairs to the Sanibel Causeway Bridge Structure span C, over San Carlos Bay. All the work will be performed over the bridge on a snooper truck. Lee County will do several "Lane Shifts" with no lane closures.

#### **Crystal Drive (Plantation Road to US 41) Water Main Improvements (ROW 2022-00020)**

**Beginning April 4, 2022**, contractors for Lee County will install new water main beginning on the west side of Planation Road just south of the roundabout with Crystal Drive. Then install the water main on the south side of Crystal Drive from Plantation Road to US 41 to tie into a connection point on the east side of US 41 just south of Crystal Drive. Crews will also install water main from a connection point on the east side of US 41 near 12499 Cleveland Avenue (PDQ). Then continue east to Austin Street and west under US 41 to the north side of Brantley Road and tie into a connection point between Pine Grove and Brantley Pines driveways. Crews are expected to work **7 AM to 7 PM**. This project is expected to be **completed in Summer 2023**. Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area.

#### **Crystal Commerce Loop West closed at Crystal Drive**

**Beginning 7 AM through 5 PM, Monday, May 23, 2022 through Friday, May 27, 2022**, crews will close Crystal Commerce Loop west at Crystal Drive for water main crossing.

- Crystal Commerce Loop west will re-open each night.
- Motorists will be directed to use Crystal Commerce Loop east for ingress and egress.

#### **Crystal Commerce Loop East closed at Crystal Drive**

**Beginning 7 AM through 5 PM, Thursday, May 23, 2022 through Friday, May 27, 2022**, crews will close Crystal Commerce Loop East at Crystal Drive for Asphalt restoration.

- Crystal Commerce Loop East will re-open each night.
- Motorists will be directed to use Crystal Commerce Loop West for ingress and egress.

### **2442 Crystal Drive and 2402 Crystal Drive: Sidewalk and Driveway Closure**

**Starting on Tuesday, May 31, 2022 through Friday, June 3, 2022**, between the hours of 7:00 AM through 5:00 PM, crews will close sidewalks and driveways for water main crossing.

### **Summerlin Force Main & Fiesta Village Reuse Main Improvements. (ROW 2022-00185)**

Andrews Sitework LLC will be installing new underground utilities on either side of Summerlin Road from Bass Road to John Morris Road in various areas and on Pine Ridge Road from Frontage Road to Safety Street. Also, as part of the project will be sidewalk replacement and landscaping and irrigation improvements.

- **WB Summerlin – Bass Road to Safety Street** - Periodic daytime right lane closures may occur between **9:00 AM & 4:00 PM** as crews work off the shoulder installing underground utilities beginning **April 18, 2022 and continuing through July 30, 2022.**
