AMENDED ROADWATCH UPDATE

July 17, 2025 to July 23, 2025

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists should expect lane closures during the nighttime/overnight hours of 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM during the week of Monday, July 21, 2025 for crews to work on storm sewer and force main crossings. Flaggers will be onsite to assist motorists.
- Motorists should drive with caution as crews are performing earthwork in the shoulders near the intersection of Corkscrew Road and Alico Road.
- Crews will be installing drainage throughout the project area on the south side of Corkscrew Road. Motorists should expect trucks and equipment to be moving materials throughout the project.
- Motorists should expect intermittent daytime flagging for crews to perform earthwork close to the roadway. The contractor is placing embankment for the new road on both the north and south sides of Corkscrew Road. Please be aware that trucks may be entering and leaving the roadway.
- A new traffic signal has been installed at the intersection of Corkscrew Road and Alico Road

which became fully operational on Thursday, April 17. Motorists are urged to drive with caution.

- Crews will be installing utility conduits and light pole bases on the south side of Corkscrew Road from Wayside Lane to Alico Road.
- Crews will be performing earthwork and transporting dirt as part of the pond construction east of Corkscrew Shores. Motorists should expect heavy truck traffic entering and leaving Corkscrew Road in that area.
- Sidewalks are closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is spring 2026. Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron Land Development, Inc. Village of Estero Corkscrew Road Shared Use Path Project: This Village of Estero project constructs a 10-foot-wide asphalt pathway on the north side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Palermo Lake Court (eastern entrance of Grandezza), and 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk from east of Palermo Lake Court that connects to the sidewalk that runs to Midnight Blue Court (Wild Blue Vista) built by Lee County's previous widening project. The 10-foot-wide asphalt pathway will also be constructed on the south side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Bella Terra Boulevard. Roadway and pathway lighting similar to those on Estero Parkway will be installed to complement the new facilities, along with a substantial amount of landscaping and irrigation which will add to the beautification of the Corkscrew Road corridor.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists should expect daytime lane closures from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM (westbound) and 8:00 AM 3:30 PM (eastbound) for crews to install irrigation in the median and continue lighting installation.
- On the north side of Corkscrew Road from Wild Blue to the west crews are scheduled to construct sidewalk.

• On the north side of Corkscrew Road between Palermo Lake Court and Wild Blue Boulevard crews are scheduled to continue earthwork in preparation for the concrete sidewalk.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is Fall 2026. Project cost is approximately \$23 million, including \$4.6 million for landscaping and irrigation and \$4 million for lighting. Sanibel Causeway Emergency Restoration: Crews are completing final items west of the toll plaza. The 35 MPH speed limit has been restored west of the toll plaza. Reduced speed limits remain enforced east of the toll plaza. Pedestrians are not permitted on the Sanibel Causeway.

The following work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

- The contractor continues work to restore the staging area at Punta Rassa in preparation for handing the area back over to Lee County later this summer.
- Motorists are advised that when traveling on island Bay 3 remains closed for Lee County to continue work on toll equipment.
- The contractor is installing signage and lighting east of the toll plaza.
- Work by others: Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation continues to monitor Least Tern nesting on the Causeway and continues work on the north side of McGregor Boulevard for mangrove restoration. For more information visit: <u>www.sccf.org</u>.

All users are urged to be courteous and pay attention as bicyclists share the road on the Causeway and vehicles are entering and existing at public beach access points of the Causeway Islands Park. Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge will replace the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span bridge that will provide a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge will be constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and will include one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water. Please use the channel when traveling through Big Carlos Pass. To contact the bridge tender, please call: 239-955-3973.

Oversize loads be aware that vertical clearance on Estero Boulevard is limited to 16 feet.

- Boaters should expect brief stoppages in the channel as crews are painting bridge piers. The channel will remain open, but please anticipate delays when traveling through the channel. The entrance of Islands End is closed for crews to work on the roadway. Access will be maintained for the west entrance.
- Motorists should continue to expect intermittent daytime lane closures with flagging for crews to perform overhead bridge work.
- The contractor is scheduled to continue setting bridge deck for the new bridge.
- Suppliers are delivering concrete to the project during times that are favorable for successful pours and within permit requirements.
- Pedestrians should follow signs to use the sidewalk on the north side of the bridge.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork and drainage work throughout the project.
- Trolley stops are available at the south entrance to Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Fort Myers Beach and across the street from Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those traveling to Lovers Key and Bonita Springs. Travelers are asked to wait behind the concrete barrier until ready to board the trolley.

TRESPASSING INTO THE CONSTRUCTION SITE IS DANGEROUS AND ILLEGAL. THIS INCLUDES THE BEACH AREA UNDER THE BRIDGE.

Pedestrians and boaters are reminded to please stay out of the work zone.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Draw bridge will remain in operation during construction and motorists should be prepared to stop. Fishing from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge is restricted due to construction activities.

Estimated completion is summer 2026. Project cost is approximately \$90.8 M. The contractor is Superior Construction. Littleton Road Widening Project from Corbett Road to US 41: The project widens Littleton Road from the Corbett Road roundabout east to US 41. The new road segment will include an 11-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane with landscaped planting islands. The project began in January 2024 with estimated completion in fall 2025. Project cost is approximately \$20 million. The contractor is Wright Construction Group, Inc.

- During the week of Monday, July 21, 2025, motorists should anticipate lane closures from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM for crews to work on roadway construction.
- Crews are currently working on roadway construction, pouring sidewalk, placing sod and installing light poles. Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution.
- Intermittent impacts to the Six Lakes and Serendipity driveways are possible as crews work on the new roadway. Please use extra caution while workers are present and pay attention to signage and flaggers.
- The Windmill Village driveway on Littleton Road has reopened to traffic. Please pay close attention to the new signage and stop locations before proceeding into the live lanes.
- Motorists are advised that eastbound and westbound traffic has shifted to the north side of the corridor throughout the length of the project to allow crews to work on the south side. Motorists entering the corridor should pay close attention to the new stop locations before proceeding into the live lanes.
- Two eastbound LeeTran bus stops on Littleton Road near Horizon Boulevard and Serendipity Boulevard are temporarily out of service. The bus stop on the corner of Littleton Road and US-41/North Cleveland Avenue near 7-Eleven is still in service.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED THAT LITTLETON ROAD IS AN ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION ZONE. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 30 MPH THROUGHOUT THE WORK ZONE. SPEEDING FINES ARE DOUBLED WHEN WORKERS ARE PRESENT.

Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An on-road bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Crews are working on the new sidewalk on the east side of Ortiz Avenue. Pedestrians are advised that the new sidewalk is in an active construction zone and will remain closed until work has been completed.
- LeeTran has installed a new temporary northbound bus stop just south of the Lee County Jail driveway. The northbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.
- Crews will continue earthwork activities.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.
- Crews will be installing drainage, force main and water main north and south of the roundabout.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Fall 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$31 M.

Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 1 from Fiddlesticks Canal to Indian Paint Lane: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north of the Fiddlesticks Canal and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. In Phase 1, there is an 8-foot-wide sidewalk on the west side of the roadway and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of the roadway.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is late 2025**. Project cost is approximately \$26.8 M. The contractor is Wright Construction Group. Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 2 from Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north in the vicinity of Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. Phase 2 includes 6-foot-wide sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.

• The contractor will be clearing the new roadway extension in the vicinity of Indian Paint Lane and adjacent to Fiddlesticks Boulevard.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is mid-2028**. Project cost is approximately \$39.7 M. The contractor is ECH Construction. Buckingham Road and Gunnery Road Roundabout Project Phase 2: Currently working in the second phase, Buckingham Road will be closed from Gunnery Road to Sunset Road beginning June 16, 2025, and is anticipated to be completed Fall 2025.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Beginning Thursday, July 24, 2025, at 7:00 PM and continuing until Friday, July 25, 2025, at 7:00 AM, Homestead Road will be closed in both directions to motorists while crews install new drainage. Residents nearby should expect lights and noise from trucks and OSHA-mandated backup beepers during the overnight work.
- Southbound Buckingham Road traffic is redirected via a detour to Gunnery Road then turn right at Sunset Road then left back onto Buckingham Road to continue south.
- Northbound Buckingham Road traffic is redirected via a detour to turn right onto Sunset Road, then left onto Gunnery Road to continue north onto Buckingham Road north.
- Additionally, temporary traffic signals have been installed at both the intersections of Buckingham Road and Sunset Road, as well as Gunnery Road and Sunset Road.
- Sidewalks will remain closed during this phase. Second Phase is anticipated to be completed Fall 2025.
- Crews will be relocating utilities along the East side of Gunnery Road.
- Crews are actively working on roadway construction along Buckingham Rd.
- As part of the construction activities for this project, sidewalk closures will be necessary. Pedestrians are encouraged to anticipate detours and make appropriate arrangements to ensure safe and efficient travel through the project site.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur; however, unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Expect large construction vehicles in the area and watch for contractors in the field. The contractors will use Variable Message Boards (VMB) to notify the public about any traffic pattern changes during construction. The contractor is V & H Construction, Inc. The project is expected to be completed in one year. Work is estimated to be complete spring of 2026. Work is expected to occur Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM; however, some night and weekend work may be necessary. Night work scheduled for Thursday July 17, 2025: LCDOT Traffic will be working on **Del Prado Boulevard** (*various intersections*) and **Burnt Store Road** (*Caloosa Parkway – Durden Parkway*) between the hours of 8:00 PM to 4:00 AM (weather permitting). Alico Road starting at Cam Court – Fort Myers (ROW2024-01000): MAJ Contracting & Clary's Site Work, Inc. will be performing roadway and sidewalk improvements beginning Monday, February 10, 2025, and continuing through July 31, 2025. Water main & Force main relocation, asphalt pavement, concrete sidewalk, concrete curbing and drainage improvements will be performed. The outside (right) lane road shoulder of the eastbound traffic on Alico Road just after Cam Court will be subject to lane closures. Six Mile Cypress at Daniels Parkway: Lee County DOT, along with their contractor Ajax Paving, will be milling, resurfacing, widening, installing new drainage and signalization on Six Mile Cypress at Daniels Parkway. The project is tentatively scheduled to start on **March 31, 2025** (weather permitting) and should be completed by the end of July, 2025. There will be intermittent nightly lane closures

Lee County will be dredging the **Whiskey Creek channel entrance between Whiskey Creek Drive and Robalo Drive** and anticipate increased construction traffic on McGreger Boulevard as a result. Daniels Parkway (B240431SSL) between the 10-Mile Canal and US 41: Electrical work for new pedestrian signal crosswalks and new traffic loops will continue within the ROW along Daniels Parkway. **Expect daily work until July 18, 2025 from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM**. The weather may affect start times and dates. Motorists should use caution while in the work zones. Please be aware of the advanced warning signs in these areas. Colonial Boulevard from Summerlin Road to McGregor Boulevard: **Beginning May 12, 2025, and continuing through Winter of 2025**, road construction and traffic signal improvements are beginning along Colonial Boulevard from Summerlin Road to McGregor Boulevard. Construction crews will be replacing the sidewalks in the areas, and detours will be in place. Expect nighttime lane closures starting July 7, 2025 through July 17, 2025, with lighted work zones between the hours of **7:00 PM to 5:00AM**. The weather may affect start times and dates. Westlinks Drive at Commerce Lakes Drive, Commerce Lakes Drive at Gateway Boulevard, Westlinks Drive N at Daniels Parkway, Gateway Greens Drive, Devonshire Lakes Drive, Fairway Lakes Drive, Girl Scout Lane - Fort Myers (ROW 2024-00255): L & S Enterprises, contracted through FPL, will be performing the rest of the electrical work on the existing poles as well as installing new poles **beginning May 27, 2025, and continuing through August 8, 2025**. New poles installation, removal of old poles, resetting poles, and energize circuits for poles will be performed. Periodic lane closures on Gateway Boulevard, shoulder work/ flagging and sidewalk closures on Westlinks Drive just south of Commerce Lakes Drive, and shoulder work/flagging on Commonwealth Drive across from the elementary school will take place. Periodic lane closures/ flagging, shoulder closures and/or shoulder closures will occur from **7:00 AM to 6:00 PM**. AWP will be conducting the traffic control services. Alico Road (Between Cemex Entrance & Wildblue Boulevard) – Fort Myers (ROW2024-01823- - LDO2024-00584-A01): Pike Gas Services, will be performing a gas main installation for TECO Peoples Gas beginning Thursday, June 26, 2025. Pike will be performing the work along the north shoulder of Alico Road. The outside (right) lane of westbound traffic on Alico Rd. beginning at the east side of the Cemex entrance ending east of Wildblue Boulevard along north shoulder of Alico Road will be subject

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to intermittent lane closures, as well as the right turn lane on Alico Road going southbound into Wildblue Boulevard, and the right lane northbound portion of Wildblue Boulevard turning east onto Alico Road. Plato Canal Crossing MH Improvements – Cape Coral (ROW2025-00862): Quality Enterprises USA, Inc. will be performing Roadway and Force main utilities improvements.

- **Phase 1 (June 15, 2025 August 18, 2025)** Manhole Doghouse Structure installation northbound and southbound inside lanes of Del Prado Boulevard between SE 40th Street and SE 40th Terrace will remain closed from **7:00 PM to 6:00 AM**.
