ROADWATCH UPDATE

October 30, 2025 to November 5, 2025

1. Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11-foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists are advised that crews will be closing Wayside Lane for force main work for one day during the daytime hours of 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. This work will occur no sooner than Thursday, November 6, 2025. More details will be provided as schedules are finalized.
- Crews will be installing curb on the south side of Corkscrew Road between Corkscrew Shores and Alico Road.
- Crews are installing sewer force main near Alico Road and at the west end of the project, as well as new water main east of Alico Road on the north side of Corkscrew Road.
- Motorists should drive with caution and expect intermittent daytime flagging as road crews are performing earthwork up to the shoulders of the road on Corkscrew Road and Alico Road, within the project limits. Please be aware that trucks may be entering and leaving the roadway.
- Crews will be installing drainage throughout the project area on the south side of Corkscrew Road. Motorists should expect trucks and equipment to be moving materials throughout the project.
- Crews will be installing utility conduits, light pole bases and light poles on the south side of

- Corkscrew Road from Wayside Lane to Alico Road.
- Sidewalks are closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Due to additional work required by Lee County Utilities, as well as delays in utility relocations by FPL and Lumen, the project completion is expected by the end of 2026. Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron Land Development, Inc. Village of Estero Corkscrew Road Shared Use Path Project: This Village of Estero project constructs a 10-foot-wide asphalt pathway on the north side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Palermo Lake Court (eastern entrance of Grandezza), and 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk from east of Palermo Lake Court that connects to the sidewalk that runs to Midnight Blue Court (Wild Blue Vista) built by Lee County's previous widening project. The 10-foot-wide asphalt pathway will also be constructed on the south side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Bella Terra Boulevard. Roadway and pathway lighting similar to those on Estero Parkway will be installed to complement the new facilities, along with a substantial amount of landscaping and irrigation which will add to the beautification of the Corkscrew Road corridor.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists should expect intermittent daytime lane closures from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM on westbound Corkscrew Road from Wild Blue Boulevard west to Ben Hill Griffin Boulevard for crews to perform earthwork.
- Motorists should expect daytime lane closures from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM on <u>eastbound</u> Corkscrew Road from Firehouse Lane to Bella Terra Boulevard for pathway and irrigation installation.
- On the north side of Corkscrew Road from Wild Blue to the west (adjacent to Grandezza), crews are scheduled to install sod behind the newly constructed sidewalk.
- WORK BY UTILITY COMPANIES: Various utilities are relocating utilities throughout the project. This work may require daytime lane closures within the project area.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is Fall 2026. Project cost is approximately \$23 million, including \$4.6 million for landscaping and irrigation and \$4 million for lighting. Sanibel Causeway Emergency Restoration: The following work activities are scheduled to occur; however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

- The contractor continues installing signage and lighting east of the toll plaza. Motorists should expect periodic shoulder closures to perform this work.
- The Punta Rassa Boat Ramp is now open to the public with limited amenities, including the ramp, partial docks, parking and restrooms. Lighting installation and landscaping continues at the toll plaza. Crews must utilize the Punta Rassa parking area, reducing the number of boat parking spaces. Please use caution as construction vehicles and crews are present.

All users are urged to be courteous and pay attention as bicyclists share the road on the Causeway and vehicles are entering and existing at public beach access points of the Causeway Islands Park. Pedestrians are not permitted on the causeway. Visitors may check www.leegov.com/parks for updates on amenities.

Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge will replace the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span bridge that will provide a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge will be constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and will include one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing

infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water.

Please use the channel when traveling through Big Carlos Pass.

FISHING IS NOT PERMITED FROM THE BIG CARLOS PASS BRIDGE

Oversize loads be aware that vertical clearance on Estero Boulevard is limited to 16 feet.

- Motorists should continue to expect intermittent daytime lane closures with flagging for crews to perform utility and bridge work.
- Crews continue construction on the west side of the new bridge. Due to this work, the east entrance of Islands End is closed. Access will be maintained at the west entrance.
- The contractor is removing the temporary trestle from the water.
- The contractor is performing concrete work throughout the job including installing curb, pedestrian railing, and sidewalk. Delivery is occurring during times that are favorable for successful pours and within permit requirements.
- Pedestrians should follow signs to use the sidewalk on the north side of the bridge.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork and drainage work throughout the project.
- Trolley stops are available at the south entrance to Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for those
 traveling to Fort Myers Beach and across the street from Black Island (Lovers Key Resort) for
 those traveling to Lovers Key and Bonita Springs. Travelers are asked to wait behind the
 concrete barrier until ready to board the trolley.

Pedestrians and boaters are reminded to please stay out of the work zone.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Draw bridge will remain in operation during construction and motorists should be prepared to stop. Fishing from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge is restricted due to construction activities.

Littleton Road Widening Project from Corbett Road to US 41: The project widens Littleton Road from the Corbett Road roundabout east to US 41. The new road segment will include an 11-foot-wide travel lane in each direction and a 12-foot-wide center turn lane with landscaped planting islands. The project began in January 2024 with estimated completion in fall 2025. Project cost is approximately \$20 million. The contractor is Wright Construction Group, Inc.

- Motorists should anticipate lane closures from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM for crews to work on various roadway construction activities.
- Crews are currently working on roadway cleanup. Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution.
- Motorists are advised that traffic may be heavy on weekdays from 8:00 AM to 9:30 AM and from 2:30 PM to 4:00 PM due to Littleton Elementary School traffic. Expect delays. Please choose an alternative route if possible. **Do not pass illegally or drive into oncoming traffic under any circumstances.**
- Two eastbound LeeTran bus stops on Littleton Road near Horizon Boulevard and Serendipity Boulevard are temporarily out of service. The bus stop on the corner of Littleton Road and US-41/North Cleveland Avenue near 7-Eleven is still in service.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

MOTORISTS ARE ADVISED THAT LITTLETON ROAD IS AN ACTIVE CONSTRUCTION ZONE. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 30 MPH THROUGHOUT THE WORK ZONE. SPEEDING FINES ARE DOUBLED WHEN WORKERS ARE PRESENT.

Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An on-road bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection

with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Motorists should expect the driveway to the Lee County Jail Complex to be reduced to one lane for crews to install new drainage pipes. Please use extra caution and follow directions from flaggers.
- Crews are working on the new sidewalk and roadway on the east side of Ortiz Avenue. Pedestrians are advised that this area an active construction zone and will remain closed until work has been completed.
- Motorists should expect heavy truck traffic entering and exiting the project area north of the roundabout.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.
- Crews will be installing fiber optic cable throughout the project limits.
- LeeTran has installed a new temporary northbound bus stop just south of the Lee County Jail driveway. The northbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Fall 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$31 M. Able Canal Pathway Project: The project constructs a new 12-foot-wide, 6-mile shared use pathway along the north side of Able Canal starting at the Harns Marsh access point next to 35th Street West and the Sailfish Canal and extending east to Joel Boulevard in Lehigh Acres. The purpose of the project is to facilitate accessible, non-motorized travel options for commuters and recreational users in the Able Canal corridor and within the Lehigh Acres community. Work includes an asphalt path with a pedestrian bridge, pavilions, landscaping and other amenities.

TRESPASSING INTO THE CONSTRUCTION SITE IS DANGEROUS AND ILLEGAL.

Please be aware that the Lee County Sheriff's Office is authorized to charge trespassers if found in the work zone.

- Crews are working on embankment, earthwork and storm drain installation at the west end of the project.
- Crews are installing erosion control throughout the project.
- Flagging and staging activity should be expected at Lehigh Acres Park, but there will be no impact to park users during construction.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. The project began in August 2025 with estimated completion in Fall 2027. Project cost is approximately \$10.2 M. The contractor is Pavement Maintenance, LLC. Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 2 from Indian Paint Lane to and including Daniels Parkway: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north in the vicinity of Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. Phase 2 includes 6-foot-wide sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. The project also includes the widening of Daniels Parkway to eight lanes from Danport Boulevard to west of Powers Court/Apaloosa Lane.

- The median opening at Cody Lee Lane/9300 Daniels Parkway at Fiddlesticks Boulevard is closed permanently.
- The median opening at Jobe Road/Kings Crossing Road at Palomino Lane is closed permanently.
- Daniels Parkway lanes are shifted to the outside of the roadway from Danport Boulevard to Powers Court/Apaloosa Lane for construction of new inside travel lanes. The traffic lane widths and the speed limit are reduced to 35 mph. Bike lanes are temporarily eliminated, and bicyclists are detoured to the adjacent multi-use paths. This configuration will remain in place for approximately one year while the inside lanes are under construction.
- The contractor is building the new roadway extension in the vicinity of Indian Paint Lane and adjacent to Fiddlesticks Boulevard to Daniels Parkway.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. Estimated completion is mid-2028. Project cost is approximately \$39.7 M. Buckingham Road and Gunnery Road Roundabout Project Phase 3: Currently working in the third phase, crews will be working on the construction of the east side of the roundabout and Gunnery Road.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- Gunnery Road will be closed from Buckingham Road to Sunset Road.
 - Southbound Gunnery Road traffic will be redirected via a detour to Buckingham Road, then turn left at Sunset Road, then right back onto Gunnery Road to continue south.
 - Northbound Gunnery Road traffic will be redirected via a detour to turn left onto Sunset Road, then right onto Buckingham Road to continue onto Buckingham Road north.
- Access to and from Gunnery Road Christian Academy and Gunnery Road Baptist Church will be maintained at all times during the project.
- Motorists should expect intermittent flagging operations between 9:00 AM 3:00 PM.
- Crews will be removing utilities along the east side of Gunnery Road.
- Additionally, temporary traffic signals have been installed at both the intersections of Buckingham Road and Sunset Road, as well as Gunnery Road and Sunset Road.
- Sidewalks will remain closed during this phase. Third Phase is anticipated to be completed Winter 2026.
- Crews are actively working on roadway construction along Buckingham Rd.
- As part of the construction activities for this project, sidewalk closures will be necessary. Pedestrians are encouraged to anticipate detours and make appropriate arrangements to ensure safe and efficient travel through the project site.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur; however, unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Expect large construction vehicles in the area and watch for contractors in the field. The contractors will use Variable Message Boards (VMB) to notify the public about any traffic pattern changes during construction. The contractor is V & H Construction, Inc. The project is expected to be completed in one

year. **Work is estimated to be completed by the spring of 2026**. Work is expected to occur **Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM**; however, some night and weekend work may be necessary.

Orange River Boulevard Sidewalk and Utility Improvements Project: The project includes water main replacement, installation of new stormwater drainage systems, addition of a new 6-foot sidewalk and curbs, and upgrading lighting and pedestrian signalization near SR 80 and Orange River Boulevard. These improvements will enhance water reliability and improve pedestrian and traffic safety.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- The Contractor will temporarily close Boatways Road entrance adjacent to the Starbucks and the entrance south of the Comfort Inn will be closed for Utility work. Only one Boatways Road entrance will be closed at a time. Motorists should proceed with caution and follow the detour signs and directions from flaggers.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur; however, unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is Fall 2026. Project cost is approximately \$3 M. The contractor is Thompkins Contracting Inc. Work is expected to occur Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM; however, some night and weekend work may be necessary. Colonial Boulevard from Summerlin Road to McGregor Boulevard: Beginning May 12, 2025, and continuing through Winter of 2025, road construction and traffic signal improvements will be continuing along Colonial Boulevard at Summerlin Road and McGregor Boulevard. Construction crews will be replacing the sidewalks and pedestrian access in the areas, and detours will be in place. Expect nighttime lane closures starting October 16, 2025, to November 7, 2025, with lighted work zones between the hours of 7:00 PM to 5:00 AM. The weather may affect start times and dates.
