AMENDED ROADWATCH UPDATE

April 2, 2026 to April 8, 2026

1. **Road Work/Maintenance/Improvement**

Corkscrew Road Widening Project – Phase 2 Construction Project: The project constructs four, 11-foot-wide travel lanes from Bella Terra Boulevard to just east of Alico Road, and a new traffic signal at the Alico Road intersection. Also included are on-road bike lanes in each direction, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on the south side of the road, a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side of the road, and street lighting. The 22-foot wide (varies) median includes various hardwood and palm trees as well as shrubs.

**Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution
when traveling through the work zone.**

- Crews will be installing concrete curb and sidewalks from Corkscrew Shores to Alico Road.
- Crews will be constructing a gravity wall on the north side of Corkscrew Road, starting at Alico Road and moving to the west. Please be aware that concrete trucks may be entering and leaving the roadway in this area.
- Crews will be installing drainage throughout the project area on Corkscrew Road and Alico Road. Motorists should expect trucks and equipment to be moving materials throughout the project.
- Motorists should drive with caution and expect intermittent daytime flagging as road crews are performing earthwork up to the shoulders of the road on Corkscrew Road and Alico Road, within the project limits. Please be aware that trucks may be entering and leaving the roadway.
- Crews will be installing utility conduits, light pole bases and light poles on the north side of Corkscrew Road from Wayside Lane to Alico Road.
- Sidewalks are closed in areas throughout the project as the contractor performs underground work.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Due to additional work required by Lee County Utilities, as well as delays in utility relocations by FPL and Lumen, the project completion is expected end of 2026. Project cost is approximately \$27 M. The contractor is Bergeron Land Development, Inc. Village of Estero Corkscrew Road Shared Use Path Project: This Village of Estero project constructs a 10-foot-wide asphalt pathway on the north side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Palermo Lake Court (eastern entrance of Grandezza), and 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk from east of Palermo Lake Court that connects to the sidewalk that runs to Midnight Blue Court (Wild Blue Vista) built by Lee County's previous widening project. The 10-foot-wide asphalt pathway will also be constructed on the south side of Corkscrew Road from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Bella Terra Boulevard. Roadway and pathway lighting similar to those on Estero Parkway will be installed to complement the new facilities, along with a substantial amount of landscaping and irrigation which will add to the beautification of the Corkscrew Road corridor.

The sidewalk and pathway are active work zones and remain closed to pedestrians and bicyclists from Ben Hill Griffin Parkway to Midnight Blue Court/Bella Terra Boulevard.

- Crews are installing lighting on the north side of the road and irrigation on both the north and south side of the road between Grandezza and Ben Hill Griffin Parkway. Please be aware of trucks and equipment entering/leaving the roadway.
- *WORK BY UTILITY COMPANIES: Various utilities are relocating utilities throughout the project. This work may require daytime lane closures within the project area.*

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is Fall 2026. Project cost is approximately \$23 million, including \$4.6 million for landscaping and irrigation and \$4 million for lighting. Big Carlos Pass Bridge Project – Construction Project: The project builds a new bridge over Big Carlos Pass, from Estrellita Drive on Fort Myers Beach to the Lovers Key State Park bayside entrance on Lovers Key. The new bridge replaces the existing moveable bridge over Big Carlos Pass with a fixed span bridge that provides a vertical navigation clearance of 60 feet. The new bridge has been constructed on the Gulf side of the existing bridge, and includes one travel lane in each direction, bicycle lanes, a six-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of Estero Boulevard, and a 10-foot-wide shared use path along the south side of Estero Boulevard. A parking area with access to the Lovers Key State Park will be included on the southeast side of the bridge. The project also includes relocation of existing infrastructure for Lee County Utilities and Bonita Springs Utilities.

Boaters are reminded to avoid the construction equipment and the temporary trestle that is in the water.

Mariners are now using the navigational channel under the new bridge.

A temporary clearance gauge is available.

FISHING IS NOT PERMITTED FROM THE BIG CARLOS PASS BRIDGE

- The contractor is performing concrete work throughout the job including installing curb, pedestrian railing, and sidewalk. Delivery is occurring during times that are favorable for successful pours and within permit requirements.
- Vehicles are now using the newly constructed, fixed-span bridge. LeeTran trolley stops on the east side of the bridge are open for service. Pedestrian and bicyclist access is limited until the completion of span 1 (closest to Fort Myers Beach).
- Motorists should continue to expect intermittent daytime lane closures with flagging for crews to perform utility and bridge work.
- Crews continue construction on the west side of the new bridge. Due to this work, the east entrance of Islands End (south side) is closed. Access will be maintained at the west entrance.
- The contractor is dismantling the old bridge, as well as removing the temporary trestle from the water.
- Pedestrians should follow signs to use the sidewalk on the north side of the bridge.
- Crews will continue performing earthwork and drainage work throughout the project.

Pedestrians and boaters are reminded to please stay out of the work zone.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway. Motorists should expect reduced speeds throughout the project area. Fishing is not permitted from the Big Carlos Pass Bridge.

Estimated completion is summer 2026. Project cost is approximately \$90.8 M. The contractor is Superior Construction. Ortiz Avenue Widening from SR 884 (Colonial Boulevard) to SR 82 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard): This project consists of widening of Ortiz Avenue from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and constructs a six-foot sidewalk on the east side of the road and a 10-foot paved trail on the west side of the road. An on-road bike lane on both sides of the road will also be included. New street lighting will be installed, and a grass median will separate traffic. No improvements will be made at the roundabout intersection with Hanson Street. The contractor will reconstruct the roadway with drainage improvements and stormwater management facilities. Work also includes installation of new water main and installation of new reclaimed water and sewer facilities for Lee County and the City of Fort Myers.

when traveling through the work zone.*

- From Thursday, April 2 to Wednesday, April 8, the entrances to Schofield Street, Fort Myers Seventh-Day Adventist Church and The Edison Apartments will be reduced to one lane for roadway construction activities. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution and follow the direction of flaggers.
- The contractor will be installing watermain near the pedestrian path north of the roundabout, on the west side of Ortiz Avenue. The path will remain open, but pedestrians are advised to proceed with caution and follow the direction of flaggers.
- The south entrance to RaceTrac on Ortiz Avenue is closed for crews to work on roadway construction. Both the northbound right turn lane and the southbound left turn lane are closed. Motorists should use the entrance to the north on Ortiz Avenue or the entrance on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to access RaceTrac.
- The Contractor will be performing utility work north and south of the roundabout.
- Crews are working on the new sidewalk and roadway on the east side of Ortiz Avenue. Pedestrians are advised that this area is an active construction zone and will remain closed until work has been completed.
- The existing pedestrian path between SR 82/Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard and the Vistas Apartments will be closed until late April for utility installations. Pedestrians are advised to follow detour signs directing them to the alternative route that utilizes Alessio Drive.

- Motorists should expect heavy truck traffic entering and exiting the project area north of the roundabout.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project.
- The contractor is scheduled to survey the project during daytime hours.
- **LeeTran riders are advised of the following bus stop changes:**
 - The southbound stop just north of the Vistas at Eastwood Apartments entrance is being temporarily relocated to about 100 feet south of the entrance.
 - The temporary northbound bus stop, which was previously located just south of the original Lee County Jail driveway, has now been moved another 250 feet to the south near the newly constructed driveway.
 - The northbound AND southbound stops just north of the Lee County Jail driveway and the northbound stop near RaceTrac are temporarily out of service.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Motorists are asked to drive with caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the work zone. **Estimated completion is Late 2026.** Project cost is approximately \$31 M. Able Canal Pathway Project: The project constructs a new 12-foot-wide, 6-mile shared use pathway along the north side of Able Canal starting at the Harns Marsh access point next to 35th Street West and the Sailfish Canal and extending east to Joel Boulevard in Lehigh Acres. The purpose of the project is to facilitate accessible, non-motorized travel options for commuters and recreational users in the Able Canal corridor and within the Lehigh Acres community. Work includes an asphalt path with a pedestrian bridge, pavilions, landscaping and other amenities.

TRESPASSING INTO THE CONSTRUCTION SITE IS DANGEROUS AND ILLEGAL.

Please be aware that the Lee County Sheriff's Office is authorized to charge trespassers if found in the work zone.

- Crews will be building forms during daytime hours for the new bridge over Charlie Diversion Canal.
- Crews are working on embankment, earthwork and storm drain installation between 35th Street West and Williams Avenue.
- Crews are installing erosion control throughout the project.

- Flagging and staging activity should be expected at Lehigh Acres Park, but there will be no impact to park users during construction.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. The project began in August 2025 with estimated completion in Fall 2027. Project cost is approximately \$10.2 M. The contractor is Pavement Maintenance, LLC. I-75 at Daniels Parkway (exit 131) Interchange Improvements: FDOT is reconstructing the I-75 at Daniels Parkway interchange. The interchange improvements include reconstruction of the Daniels Parkway Interchange (Exit 131) converting it to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) design, reconstruction of the I-75 ramps, construction of pedestrian and bicycle accommodations through the interchange, installation of new signals at the ramps, and resurfacing of Daniels Parkway through the project area.

The following activities are subject to change based on weather conditions and unforeseen underground conditions:

- From Thursday, April 9 at 9 p.m. to Friday, April 10 at 7 a.m., motorists should anticipate a **full closure of the northbound I-75 off-ramp** for crews to work on milling and resurfacing. Motorists are advised to follow the posted detour routes or find alternative routes.
- During the nighttime/overnight hours of 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., motorists should anticipate lane closures on northbound I-75 for crews to work on temporary roadway construction.
- Crews are working on widening at the southbound I-75 off-ramp and Daniels Parkway.
- Crews are working on earthwork and underground drainage throughout the project area.
- Please note that the westbound lanes on Daniels Parkway, west of I-75, are shifted slightly to the south, then back to the north. Traffic on the southbound I-75 off-ramp has also shifted to the east. Please pay attention to signs and pavement marking and drive with caution.
- Motorists are advised that the speed limit has been reduced in the project area. Please follow all posted signage.
- Pedestrian access has been shifted to the south side of Daniels Parkway. Please follow signs and proceed with caution in the work zone.
- Motorists should expect trucks and equipment to be moving materials throughout the project.
- When necessary, motorists should anticipate lane closures on I-75 between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. and

on Daniels Parkway between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m., with the exception of three hours before, during and three hours after Spring Training baseball games at Hammond Stadium and Jet Blue Park.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. The expected completion date is summer 2028. Bell Boulevard Sidewalk from Sunrise Boulevard to Joel Boulevard: Lee County is constructing a 6-foot sidewalk on Bell Boulevard in Lehigh Acres from Sunrise Boulevard to Joel Boulevard. This project, when complete, will provide a continuous sidewalk connecting pedestrians from SR 82 to Joel Boulevard via Bell Boulevard. The project also includes a steel pedestrian bridge over Jim Canal, concrete driveway replacements, minor roadway reconstruction, paving, drainage improvements, and pedestrian safety upgrades. Construction is scheduled to begin in late March 2026, with completion anticipated in Fall 2026. Project cost is approximately \$1.5 million. The contractor is V&H Construction.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.

- The contractor is scheduled to be surveying the area during daytime hours.
- Crews will be installing erosion control and traffic control devices throughout the project.
- The contractor is identifying existing utility locations throughout the project. Crews may be working close to the roadway. Motorists are asked to drive with caution.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur, however unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Estero Boulevard Hurricane Repairs (Estrellita Drive to Crescent Street) – Construction Project: This project includes repairs of damaged asphalt, curb and gutter, sidewalk, pavement, pedestrian handrail, school flashers, pedestrian signals, as well as the removal and replacement of the pervious paver drainage facilities. The contractor will also replace ADA ramps and detectible warning surfaces.

Estrellita Drive to Buccaneer Drive

- Crews have begun installing signage and erosion control.
- Crews are currently removing damaged concrete, such as sidewalk, curb, and gutter. Extended lane closures are not anticipated for this work; however, motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists are encouraged to slow down and use caution.

Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution when traveling through the work zone as workers and construction vehicles are entering and leaving the roadway.

Three Oaks Parkway Extension Project Phase 2 from Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway: This project consists of extending Three Oaks Parkway north in the vicinity of Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway and constructs 4 lanes with a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane. Phase 2 includes 6-foot-wide sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.

Daniels Parkway:

- *Beginning the week of April 6, Palomino Lane will be closed from Jobe Road / Kings Crossing to Daniels Parkway and will remain closed for about six weeks.* This is necessary for the installation of a new drainage pipe and water main under the road, followed by roadway reconstruction. A traffic detour will be routed from Kings Crossing to Skyport Avenue to Mall Loop Road to Danport Boulevard.
- Thursday, April 2 nighttime/overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., the inside lanes of Daniels Parkway will be closed at Powers Court/Apaloosa Lane while crews work on the future traffic signal.
- Beginning Monday, April 6 through Thursday, April 9 nighttime/overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Daniels Parkway at Fiddlesticks Boulevard/Palamino Lane will experience intermittent all stop road closures for traffic signal work.

- Daniels Parkway is open to three lanes of traffic in each direction. The outside east and westbound lanes will remain closed for additional construction activities. However, the outside right-turn lanes will be open for use.

Three Oaks Parkway Extension:

- Daniels 9300 Service Access Road is closed at Fiddlesticks Boulevard as the contractor continues to build the northbound lanes for Three Oaks Parkway Extension. This work is expected to be complete at the beginning of May.
- The contractor is constructing connections to the new roundabout to connect to Fiddlesticks Boulevard.

Buckingham Road and Gunnery Road Roundabout Project Phase 3: The project is nearing completion.

- The roundabout is now open to traffic, and the traffic signals have been deactivated.
- Sidewalks will remain closed until completion of the project. Pedestrians are encouraged to anticipate detours and make appropriate arrangements to ensure safe and efficient travel through the project site.

The project is expected to be completed in one year. **Work is estimated to be completed by the spring of 2026.** Work is expected to occur **Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM**; however, some night and weekend work may be necessary. Orange River Boulevard Sidewalk and Utility Improvements Project: The project includes water main replacement, installation of new stormwater drainage systems, addition of a new 6-foot sidewalk and curbs, and upgrading lighting and pedestrian signalization in the surrounding area of Orange River Boulevard from Palm Beach Boulevard (SR 80) to east of Lorraine Drive. These improvements will enhance water reliability and improve pedestrian and traffic safety.

**Drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists are urged to use extra caution
when traveling through the work zone.**

- Crews will be pouring curb and gutter in the Right of Way (ROW).
- Crews will be patching asphalt throughout the project area.
- Crews will be working on utilities in the Right of Way (ROW) along the north and south side of Orange River Blvd. They will start at Lakeside Club Dr. and work eastward. **Intermittent flagging operations may be necessary.**
- Boatways Road entrance adjacent to the Starbucks and the entrance south of the Comfort Inn is temporarily closed for Utility work and sidewalk construction. Only one Boatways Road entrance will be closed at a time. Motorists should proceed with caution and follow the detour signs and directions from flaggers.

The work activities above are scheduled to occur; however, unforeseen underground conditions and weather may affect this schedule.

Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway. Estimated completion is Fall 2026. Project cost is approximately \$3M.
