at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.

Studies on file: The current posted speed on Cape Coral Parkway between Del Prado Boulevard and a point about 800 feet east is 35 MPH, with a 45 MPH Speed Zone in place to the east towards the Bridge. Based on the changes in land use to a more urban type with higher densities and increased side-street/driveway turning movements, the 45 MPH Speed Limit in the 1,500-foot section to the east of the existing 35 MPH Zone is recommended to be lowered. The recommended change will provide for a 35 MPH Zone from Del Prado Boulevard to a point approximately 2,300 feet east of Del Prado Boulevard.
