I hereby direct that the existing stop controls on Hanna Avenue N be reversed with Hanna Avenue N designated as the preferential street.

at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.

Studies on file: Based on the area street network and field observations the higher volume street is Hanna Avenue N. Hanna Avenue functions as a residential collector road, with 18th Street W and 20th Street W thru 26th Street W operating as local streets. 19th Street W serves as the major east/west street in the area, and should remain the preferential road at Hanna Avenue. There is no apparent rationale based on existing traffic conditions and street network for Hanna Avenue traffic to stop at each of the identified minor side streets. 20th Street W thru 26th Street W terminate to the west of Hanna Avenue at a canal. Reversing the stop controls will bring the intersection controls into compliance with recommended MUTCD guidelines.
