Location: Southwell Drive, from Plantation Road to Brookshire Lake Boulevard

I hereby direct that the a No Thru Truck prohibition be established

at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.

This regulation shall be effective upon posting.

Initiated by: Brookshire Subdivision residents.

Recommended by: Bryan Miller, Senior Project Manager (LCDOT)

Studies on file: Since the opening of Whole Foods and other commercial businesses in the Daniels Marketplace center in the northeast quadrant of the Brookshire Lake Boulevard and Daniels Parkway intersection circa November 2017, service trucks have been using Southwell Drive to and from Plantation Road to gain access to the commercial development. Alternate delivery truck access is available using Plantation Road, Daniels Parkway, and Brookshire Lake Boulevard. Southwell Drive is a local residential street with the Brookshire Bath & Tennis Club Association property abutting on the south side. Trucks to and from the commercial development should not be using this local residential street for deliveries. To provide relief to the residents living on this road, a No Thru Truck prohibition is appropriate.
