at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.


This regulation shall be effective upon posting.

Studies on file: November 2022 Intersection Count. Both roads operate as residential collectors based on the street network, and the volume distribution is approximately equal. Converting this intersection to an all way stop control will provide an interruption in the flow of traffic and be considered a neighborhood traffic mitigation measure. The MUTCD allows for the consideration of this control at the intersection of two similar residential collector roads.
