Location: Wood Avenue south of Palm Beach Boulevard.


I hereby direct that a “No Parking” restriction be established within the right of way at the above-named location, in accordance with the attached detail (WO 25-54). This regulation shall be effective upon posting of the signs.

Initiated by: Lee County Sheriff’s Office

Recommended by: Lee County Department of Transportation

Studies on file: Due to frequent parking on both sides of Wood Avenue in the right-of-way within the identified commercial segment, traffic flow along Wood Avenue for the residential portion is impeded including pedestrian access to Palm Beach Boulevard. Wood Avenue is a county-maintained roadway. Each of the commercial properties are required to have adequate parking on-site for their operations. The “No Parking” restriction will allow for the residential portion to access Palm Beach Boulevard for both vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
